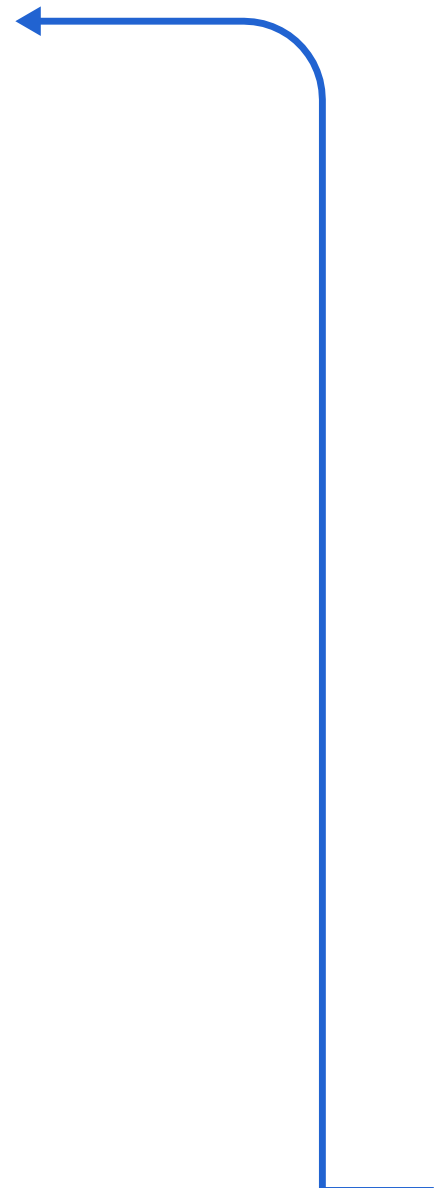




# Affordable Care Act (ACA) \$0 Drug List.

## ACA Preventive Drug List

Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA) some medications may have limited or \$0 cost-sharing. Examples of categories of medications that may be subject to limited or \$0 cost share include the following:

- Aspirin
- Breast cancer preventive
- Fluoride supplements
- Folic acid supplements
- Immunizations (Vaccines)
- Iron supplements
- Bowel preparation agents for colonoscopy
- Contraceptive medications and devices

- Which medicines, supplements, health-related products or vaccines are covered.
- Who they are covered for (such as children up to an age of 16 or adults age 45 to 74).
- What health condition or illness they help prevent.

Please note, your doctor must write a prescription for these preventive services to be covered by your plan, even if they are listed as OTC (over-the-counter). Generic or brand name is listed if only that product type is covered and other rules, limits and exclusions may apply.

## Preventive Services

**Aspirin** to help prevent illness and death in pregnant women (after 12 weeks of gestation) who are at high risk for preeclampsia.

- Aspirin chew tab 81mg
- Aspirin enteric coated tab 81mg

**Fluoride Supplements** to help prevent dental caries (cavities) in children birth through 16 years whose water supply is deficient in fluoride.

- Fluoride chewable tablets 0.25mg and 0.5mg
- Sodium fluoride solution 0.125mg, 0.25mg, and 0.5mg
- Sodium fluoride tablets 0.5mg

**Iron Supplements** to help prevent anemia due to iron deficiency in children 6-12 months of age.

- Iron liquid (ferrous sulfate) supplement drops 15 mg/ml elemental Fe

**Folic Acid Supplements** for the prevention of neural tube defects (birth defects) in women age 55 or younger who are planning to become pregnant or are able to become pregnant.

- Folic acid tablets 400mcg and 800mcg

**Erythromycin Ophthalmic** Ointment to prevent gonococcal ophthalmia neonatorum for newborn babies 0-1 month of age

- Erythromycin ophthalmic ointment 0.5%

**Immunizations (Vaccines)** to prevent specific illnesses in people of all ages. Recommended doses, ages and populations vary

**Breast Cancer Prevention Medications** for women aged 35 and older who are at increased risk for breast cancer.

- Anastrozole tablet 1 mg
- Exemestane tablet 25 mg
- Raloxifene HCl tablet 60 mg
- Tamoxifen citrate tablet 10 mg and 20 mg
