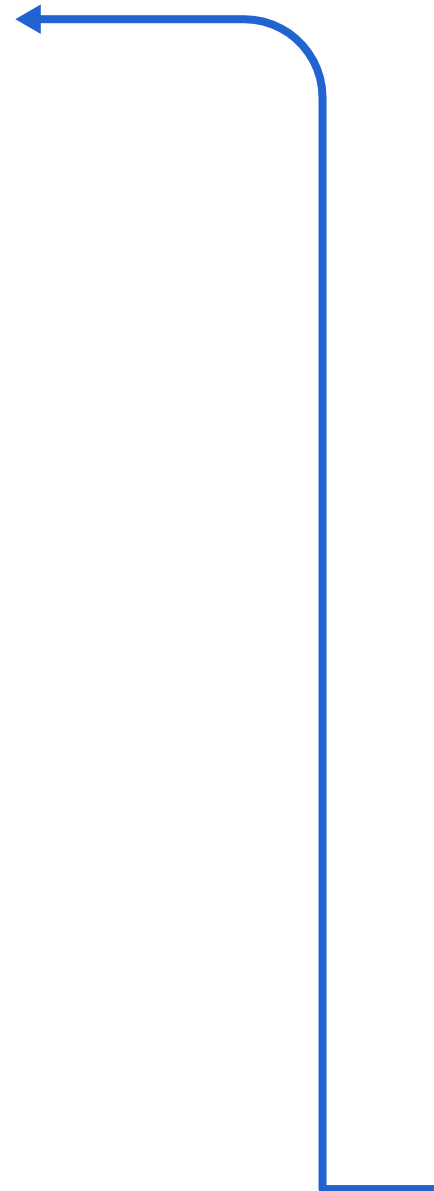

ACA Preventative Drug List

Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA) some medications may have limited or \$0 cost-sharing. Examples of categories of medications that may be subject to limited or \$0 cost share include the following:

- Aspirin
- Breast cancer preventive
- Fluoride supplements
- Folic acid supplements
- Immunizations (Vaccines)
- Iron supplements
- Tobacco cessation
- Bowel preparation agents for colonoscopy
- Contraceptive medications and devices

Rightway works with your health plan to provide these benefits. The following lists explain:

- Which medicines, supplements, health-related products or vaccines are covered.
- Who they are covered for (such as children up to an age of 16 or adults age 45 to 74).
- What health condition or illness they help prevent.

Please note, your doctor must write a prescription for these preventive services to be covered by your plan, even if they are listed as OTC (over-the-counter). Generic or brand name is listed if only that product type is covered and other rules, limits and exclusions may apply.

Preventive Services

Aspirin to help prevent illness and death in pregnant women (after 12 weeks of gestation) who are at high risk for preeclampsia.

- Aspirin chew tab 81mg
- Aspirin enteric coated tab 81mg

Fluoride Supplements to help prevent dental caries (cavities) in children birth through 16 years whose water supply is deficient in fluoride.

- Fluoride chewable tablets 0.25mg and 0.5mg
- Sodium fluoride solution 0.125mg, 0.25mg, and 0.5mg
- Sodium fluoride tablets 0.5mg

Iron Supplements to help prevent anemia due to iron deficiency in children 6-12 months of age.

- Iron liquid (ferrous sulfate) supplement drops 15 mg/ml elemental Fe

Folic Acid Supplements for the prevention of neural tube defects (birth defects) in women age 55 or younger who are planning to become pregnant or are able to become pregnant.

- Folic acid tablets 400mcg and 800mcg

Erythromycin Ophthalmic Ointment to prevent gonococcal ophthalmia neonatorum for newborn babies 0-1 month of age

- Erythromycin ophthalmic ointment 0.5%

Preventive Services

Tobacco Cessation Products to help adults quit tobacco use in order to prevent future health problems. Tobacco use includes smoking or chewing tobacco.

- Bupropion HCl SR tablet 150mg
- Chantix tablet 0.5mg and 1mg
- Chantix tablet starter pack (0.5mg X 11 tabs and 1mg X 42 tabs)
- Nicotine polacrilex gum 2mg and 4mg
- Nicotine polacrilex lozenge 2mg and 4mg
- Nicotine transdermal patch 21mg, 14mg, and 7mg
- Nicotrol inhaler system 10mg
- Nicotrol NS nasal spray 10mg/mL

Immunizations (Vaccines) to prevent specific illnesses in people of all ages. Recommended doses, ages and populations vary

Bowel Preparations for use prior to a colonoscopy procedure for adults age 45 to 74. Colonoscopies screen for colon and rectal cancers.

- Bisacodyl 5mg tablets
- Magnesium citrate solution
- PEG-3350 electrolyte solution
- Gaviscon (N, G, and C) solution

Preventive Services

Statins for the primary prevention of cardiovascular disease in adults aged 40 to 75 years who are at risk.

- Atorvastatin 10mg, 20mg
- Lovastatin 10mg, 20mg, 40mg
- Pravastatin 10mg, 20mg, 40mg, 80mg
- Rosuvastatin 5mg, 10mg
- Simvastatin 5mg, 10mg, 20mg, 40mg

Antiretroviral therapy for preexposure prevention of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) infection in people who are at an increased risk.

- Emtricitabine-tenofovir tablet 200-300mg

Women's Health Preventive Services

Breast Cancer Prevention Medications for women aged 35 and older who are at increased risk for breast cancer.

- Anastrozole tablet 1 mg
- Exemestane tablet 25 mg
- Raloxifene HCl tablet 60 mg
- Tamoxifen citrate tablet 10 mg and 20 mg
