Moving Checklist

From 60 days out to move-in day – the complete timeline.



30-60 Days Before Moving


This is the time to set everything in motion. The earlier you act, the more options you'll have – especially when it comes to booking movers.

- Confirm your moving date with your new landlord
- Give written notice to your current landlord (check your lease, as this varies by province)
- Make a room-by-room inventory of your belongings 
- Donate, sell, or discard anything you no longer need
- Get quotes from licensed, insured moving companies
- Stock up on boxes, packing tape, bubble wrap, and markers
- Book your moving company and get everything in writing
- Start packing non-essentials: books, décor, out-of-season clothing, etc.

Label every box with its contents AND the destination room – not just 'kitchen stuff'.

15-30 Days Before Moving

The bulk of packing happens now. Use this window to sort out the admin that's easy to forget until something goes wrong.

- Finish packing (leave out only daily essentials)
- Notify your bank and update automatic payments 
- Get tenant insurance before move-in day (most landlords require it)
- Transfer electricity, gas, and internet to your new address
- Update streaming services, subscriptions, and regular deliveries



Scroll through your bank statement to catch any recurring charges with your old address attached.


The Week of Your Move


Stay calm, stay organised, and keep your essentials bag close at all times.

- Pack an essentials bag to travel with you
 - Charger, medications, change of clothes, toiletries, toilet paper
 - Important documents: lease, ID, insurance
 - A set of bedding or at minimum, a pillow
- Deep clean your old apartment
- Photograph every room after cleaning
- Do a final walkthrough – check every closet, drawer, and shelf, just in case
- Return all keys, fobs, and parking passes; get written confirmation of this
- Call your movers to confirm arrival time, address, and access details
- Move!**

After You Move In

You made it. Now make the new place feel like home – one step at a time.

- Set up your bedroom first, then bathroom, then kitchen
- Update your address with Canada Post (set up a mail redirect)
- Update CRA, employer, bank, driver's licence, and health card 
- Read your lease and building rules (quiet hours, garbage, amenities, etc.)
- Explore your neighbourhood: grocery store, pharmacy, transit stops

Your bank statement is the fastest way to find every account still tied to your old address.
