Hospital to Home service



The Hospital to Home service is for NDIS participants who are stuck in hospital with no suitable housing to go to when they leave. We welcome self-referrals from NDIS participants, and referrals from anyone supporting an NDIS participant in hospital, including hospital teams, NDIS support coordinators, family members and guardians.

If you're considering using this service, please chat to your hospital team or support coordinator so we can all work together.

What do we do?

- Hold a meeting to understand the needs and preferences of the person seeking housing
- Provide information about the types of housing available
- Assist with evidence requirements from the NDIS
- Complete an innovative search for interim and/or long-term housing and present the options back with detailed information
- Support the completion of housing applications
- Provide guidance to support a good transition out of hospital
