UPDATED STATEMENT OF ISSUES OF THE RESPONDENT

1. The matter is listed for a second case conference on 7 August 2023 at 2:15pm
2. The Applicant is 24 years old (DOB 17/02/1999) and currently lives with her partner in Canberra, ACT.
3. The Applicant has been diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis, depression and anxiety, hearing loss, hypothyroidism, obesity, and obstructive sleep apnoea (**T1B, page 10**).
4. The application is for review of a decision concerning reasonable and necessary supports that will be funded under the National Disability Insurance Scheme (**NDIS**).
5. References to the NDIS Act are references to the *National Disability Insurance Scheme Act 2013* and references to the NDIS Rules are references to the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (Supports for Participants) Rules 2013* unless otherwise stated.
