

Worldwide Digital Asset-Based ETPs AUM Surges To \$150 Billion Reaching New All-Time High

London, UK, Nov. 5, 2024 – Fineqia International Inc. (the "Company" or "Fineqia") (CSE: FNQ) (OTC: FNQQF) (Frankfurt: FNQA), a leading digital asset and investment business, announces that its analysis of global Exchange Traded Products (ETPs) with underlying digital assets revealed that Assets Under Management (AUM) reached a new all-time high (ATH) of \$150 billion in November, a 49.2% increase from \$100.5 billion at the end of October, surpassing the previous ATH established only one month ago.

The digital asset market cap grew by 40.7% to \$3.57 trillion, up from \$2.54 trillion during November, setting a new ATH and exceeding the previous record of \$3.07 trillion achieved during the last bull run in November 2021. Year-to-date, this marks a 101.6% increase from \$1.77 trillion at the end of 2023. Over the same period, ETPs' AUM rose by 202.6%, climbing from \$49.5 billion at the start of the year, doubling the growth rate of the underlying assets.

This premium largely reflects the approval of Bitcoin (BTC) Spot ETFs, which since inception have attracted a net inflow of approximately \$30.7 billion. In November, however, Ethereum (ETH) ETPs and major altcoin ETPs also saw net inflows, contributing to the positive trend for financial instruments backed by digital assets.

"The \$30.7 billion in net inflows to BTC spot ETFs underscores their dominance, but November marked a turning point," said Fineqia's CEO Bundeep Singh Rangar. "ETH and altcoin ETPs joined the party, adding new momentum to the growing appeal of digital asset-backed financial instruments."

In November, BTC price increased by 37.2%, rising to \$96,485 from \$70,350 at the end of October. During the same period, the AUM of BTC ETPs grew by 49.6%, reaching \$124.4 billion from \$83.2 billion. This surpassed the previous ATH recorded last month and crossed the \$100 billion AUM milestone for the first time.

Year-to-date, BTC's price has risen by 128.1%, to \$96,485 from \$42,290 at the end of 2023. In the same period, BTC ETPs' AUM has surged by 249.7%, rising to \$124.4 billion from \$35.6 billion. This reflects a 94.9% premium in ETPs holding BTC relative to the underlying asset, highlighting BTC's substantial influence on the ETP premium throughout 2024.

Ethereum (ETH) recorded a 47.2% price increase in November, rising to \$3,711 from \$2,521 at October's close. During the same period, the AUM of ETH ETPs rose by 44%, growing to \$14.9 billion from \$10.3 billion. Year-to-date, ETH's price has increased by 63%, rising from \$2,277 at the end of 2023, while the AUM of ETH ETPs has grown by 57.5%, climbing from \$9.4 billion to \$14.9 billion.

Notably, November marked the first time the cumulative net flow since the inception of ETH spot ETFs turned positive, with a cumulative net inflow of about \$573 million. This was driven by strong inflows during November, which saw nearly \$1.1 billion in net flows into ETH spot ETFs in the US.

ETPs representing a diversified basket of cryptocurrencies experienced a 38% rise in AUM during November, growing from \$3.26 billion at the end of October to \$4.5 billion. Year-to-date, these ETPs have seen their AUM double, increasing by 100% from \$2.25 billion at the start of the year.

The AUM of ETPs tracking an index of alternative coins grew by 64.8% in November, reaching \$6.02 billion, up from \$3.65 billion in October. Year-to-date, AUM for ETPs holding alternative coins has increased by 169.7%, from \$2.23 billion.

Remarkably, ETPs holding Ripple (XRP) as the underlying asset saw a 553.2% increase in AUM during November, rising to \$627.9 million from \$96.1 million at the end of October. Other prominent altcoins also recorded remarkable growth, with Cardano (ADA) AUM increasing by 228.7%, Algorand (ALGO) AUM rising by 255.8%, and Sui (SUI) AUM surging by 373.1%.

Fineqia Research's AUM calculation factors in the launch or closure of ETPs during any stated period. The number of tracked ETPs stood at 232 as of the end of November.
