“But when the kindness and love of God, our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy.”

Often our understanding of the word justice is focused on how things should be done. We focus on rules, expectations, rights and wrongs. However, the Biblical view, found in the Hebrew expression of justice, reflects the merciful restoration of how life could be.

The definition of mercy is to have compassion or forgiveness towards someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm. It was in His kindness that He sent Jesus with love and mercy.
