For children living in poverty, falling sick can quickly become life-threatening without timely medical support. Over half the world's population does not have access to essential healthcare, and basic health knowledge that could save lives is out of reach for many vulnerable communities.

### 9-year-old Clara recovered from a brain infection

When Clara was 5 years old she suffered a brain infection, and doctors weren't sure if she would wake up from her coma. Survival was the first step, which was followed by hundreds of physiotherapy sessions over the next few years to recover.

Her mother Betty saw God's hand in her healing, sharing, "My heart was sorrowful seeing my daughter's body fitted with a heart monitor and several other devices. The rapid change in the situation left many questions in my heart. Deep down, I remembered the God I had not believed in, and I told my husband that I wanted to accept Him, Christ, as my Lord. I asked God to heal my daughter. God answered my prayers.

"I believe that God determines everyone's life. My child is registered with the Compassion program, which is God's way of helping us. If not, how would we pay transportation costs to the hospital three or four times weekly for physiotherapy sessions?"



#### Cases of malaria reduced by over 50 per cent in Maizimasa

In Maizimasa, Uganda, it was heartbreakingly common for children to die from malaria. The local church refused to accept this reality, providing children with education, mosquito nets and nutrition to boost their immunity.

Health Officer Sellesling now reports, "In 2022, we registered 185 malaria cases. But in 2024, we only had 89



### 120 more children in Tierralta are now brushing their teeth

In Tierralta, Colombia, it is rare for children to visit the dentist, with many children only going when they already have an oral illness. Through a Health intervention, 120 children plus their parents were able to learn about good hygiene habits.

5-year-old Sharon is now brushing her teeth regularly and using dental floss and mouthwash, a simple practice that has boosted her confidence and health. She shares, "I feel happy because I have healthy teeth!"
