Jorge is now reading and writing

In Guatemala, Jorge could not attend school because of his separation anxiety disorder. His local church connected Jorge with a psychologist to overcome his anxiety, but by then he was 11 and no schools would accept him. Through Education and Training, our local partner was able to create an educational support centre where children like Jorge are now thriving!

Jorge says, "I thought attending school didn't matter. Working in the field with my dad was enough. When I entered the educational support centre, I knew nothing, not even the vowels. Thanks to Sister Marivel, I now understand the date when looking at the calendar and what my Bible says. It's a beautiful thing, knowing how to read."



Dhivan is now working in a hotel

Because he was a slow learner with special needs, no school in the area was willing to enrol Dhivan—but his local Compassion centre in Sri Lanka was. As he grew, staff patiently helped Dhivan learn. When his mother tragically passed away, staff knew they had to do more to support Dhivan and looked for vocational training opportunities. Dhivan successfully undertook a course to be a room attendant, and now at 21 years old, he has secured a job in a hotel!

"I wash the dishes, clean the tables, arrange the rooms at the hotel," Dhivan explains.

Tutor Priyadarshani shares, "His mother was so happy when we took time to help Dhivan. When she saw him writing his own name she was filled with joy. I am glad she got to see that."



Yamikani is now a trained plumber

Life has not been kind to 17-year-old Yamikani. From a young age, he had to look after himself. Seeing his situation, his local church enrolled him in a training program to become a plumber, changing the trajectory of his life.

"I was just living—no purpose, no vision or dream, just waiting for the day I would die. Hearing about the program was like a flashlight chasing away the dark side of my life. For the first time, I felt my life was worth living. I imagined I was a man with a future to look forward to.

"Before this, all I could pray for was food. Then, I thought God never cared about me. I now believe that He is always keeping the best things for us. Now I pray for Him to sustain me so that I can fulfil the big dreams ahead of me."
