About the study

This study compared 4,207 Hinge Health chronic program members to 4,207 members in a matched control group and looked at the difference in medical care costs and utilization in the 12 months before and after.



- 2-year medical claims dataset represented more than
 100 million commercially insured members
- Intervention and control groups were matched on multiple characteristics including age, gender, geographic region, comorbidities, body region of MSK pain, MSK services utilization, MSK cost, and overall medical care cost.
- 46 industries were represented with manufacturing making up the largest sector (49%)
