Reserved Gion Festival Seating (July 17, July 24 | 30 Raised Seats | $\frac{1}{2}$ 18,000): Held annually since 869, the Gion Festival is one of Kyoto's most iconic celebrations. Originally held to appease the gods during an epidemic, it now promotes good health and wards off evil spirits. HOTEL THE MITSUI KYOTO is the only hotel with reserved seating along the parade route, providing unparalleled views of the parade's highlight, the Tsujimawashi. During this maneuver, massive floats execute 90-degree turns with the help of bamboo poles.

Summer Afternoon Tea (July 1-August 31 | \$7,100 for two drinks or \$7,700 unlimited drinks): A treat for all ages, this limited-time Afternoon Tea is inspired by the vibrant street food that has become a cherished tradition during Japan festivals. The menu includes savory bites like Takoyaki, or cooked octopus arancini, along with sweet delicacies such as a Taiyaki cookie sandwich, a fish-shaped pastry with a mousseline sauce. Guests also receive a traditional paper fan – a classic festival accessory – as a special keepsake.

This offer includes a second adjacent room at half the price, with complimentary perks, such as an extra bed and free upgrades when available.
