With a view of the Koudaiji-Mountains, Moon Garden and the surrounding pond framed by cherry blossoms, this tour promises to cleanse the soul.

Afternoon Tea (March 15-April 26 | ¥7,100): A limited-time Afternoon Tea features exquisite pastries in stunning pink hues inspired by cherry blossoms. The Afternoon Tea encompasses a variety of sweet and savory delights crafted with precision, like Sushi with Sea Bream and Cherry Jelly, Vanilla Strawberry Mousse, and local Strawberry Jam and Whipped Soy Cream.

YOGA (April 1-5 | \$8,000): Tailored to peak cherry blossom season in Kyoto, guests will be immersed in the beauty of spring with a serene YOGA experience in the cherry blossom-dotted Garden courtyard. Each 45-minute session offers a connection with nature, with poses often emulating natural elements like trees and mountains.
