


Total Capital Raised

The goal of the NZX is to provide businesses with access to capital to fuel their growth and contribution to the economy. We have seen a steady upward trend in total capital raised on market over the past five years. There has been \$2.04b in capital raised in June alone, bringing the total year to date to \$9.37b.



Market Capitalisation as % of GDP

Market capitalisation closely mimics GDP. We have seen a steady increase over time, with strong recovery post the initial covid lockdown shock in 2020.



Trading Volumes and Value, June 2022




Following May, June saw a decrease in trading across both wholesale and retail trades.

June has seen strong capital raising activity. Debt capital raises were completed by a total of five listings; BNZ, ASB, Infratil, and Vector, also including one new green bond listing by Genesis, bringing the total to fifteen debt listings so far in 2022, adding approximately NZD \$3.4 billion to our debt market, and delivering income streams to investors.
