

MasterCast 727

Compaction aid and water repellent admixture.

Material description

MasterCast 727 is a low viscosity emulsion to be used as a high-performance integral waterproofer for wet or dry cast concrete, having additionally a plasticizing effect. It promotes easier compaction of the concrete elements produced by vibro-compression. On curing it provides a waterproof surface/product with minimum effect on the original appearance and texture.

4 Value

In compliance with the European Regulation (EU No 305/2011 and EU No. 574/2014) the product is provided with the CE marking according to UNI EN 934-2 and the relative DoP (Declaration of Performance).



Dosage rate

Dosage rates will depend on the type of product, mix and degree of waterproofing required.

The normally recommended dosage rate is:

By volume -0.4 to 2.0 liters per 100 kg of cement (binder). Users should carry out trials with their mix to achieve the optimum dosage.

Other dosages may be used in special cases according to specific job site conditions. In this case please consult our Technical Services Department.

Packaging and storage

MasterCast 727 is available in 10L cans, 1.000L tanks and in bulk delivery.

MasterCast 727 must be stored indoors in a place where temperature does not drop below + 5°C.

If product has frozen, thaw at + 30°C and agitate until complete reconstitution. Store under cover out of direct sunlight and protect from extremes of temperature.

Failure to comply with the recommended storage conditions may result in premature deterioration of the product or packaging.

Shelf life

12 months if stored in accordance with manufacturer's instructions in unopened containers.

Directions for use

Add to the mix with the mixing water. Some water reduction may be experienced. Setting times and strength development are unaffected. All cast products should be protected from rain for 24-36 hours after casting to allow the MasterCast 727 to develop full waterproofing.

Products made incorporating MasterCast 727 can be cured at elevated temperatures and/or humidity's (not steam). Do not cure products in water.
