This is a walking food tour where you can enjoy fresh and hearty sushi, while watching lively conversations take place in the market. On this tour, you can eat sushi toppings that would cost thousands of yen at upscale restaurants for only hundreds of yen, and you can enjoy rare sushi toppings that you normally don't see. You will have some fresh sushi while enjoying the view of the Kanmon Straits. The Kanmon Straits is the gateway between Honshu and Kyushu. With Kyushu separated by the sea in the distance, the dynamic scenery of the straits will undoubtedly shine through your photos. The Kanmon Straits is also the site of a historic battlefield, where the war between the Taira clan and Minamoto clan took place in the twelfth century. As an exception, we do sit and eat on the wooden deck along the straits when guests request to do so or on sunny days.</li> </ul>
