Key Point (1) Show with photo	<p>II . Experience craftsmanship by casting a tumbler!</p> <p>After visiting the shrine, you will experience metal casting in an old, retro Japanese-style house. Hofu is a town of casted metal where metal casting is said to have already been prevalent 1,200 years ago. In addition, tin has been gaining renewed interest for its sustainable recyclability, which is a quality that allows us to make the best use of limited resources. Tin has also been used as a material that has antibacterial properties and is resistant to oxidation and corrosion. Craftsmen from a metal casting company, which has a history that dates back from the Edo period, will teach you the relevant techniques, and with these, you will create an original tumbler that is the only one of its kind in the world.
