Afterwards, you'll be able to savor the dignified atmosphere of the tearoom while enjoying some matcha green tea. The tour will then take you to the Taiko-no-Yu Museum, where you'll learn about the relationships Japan's greats had with hot springs; to a beautiful waterfall; and more.
