




Key Point (1) Show with photo	I . Catch seasonal fish from Naruto Strait under the guidance of experienced fishermen! Naruto Strait is a popular fishing spot even for fishermen, as its swift currents give rise to deliciously fatty fish. An experienced skipper will "read" the currents on the day of the tour and guide you to a favorable fishing spot. So that even beginners will be able to enjoy themselves on board, members of the local community will be on the boat as support staff, teaching you how to fish and giving you an opportunity to interact with the locals.		Other Information	■ Participation Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Depending on weather conditions on the day of the tour, children of elementary school age or younger may be asked to refrain from participating in the tour. In addition, adults are asked to keep a watchful eye on their children while on the boat, including when the boat is moving and when you are actually fishing.

If the weather is good, you will be able to enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Seto Inland Sea from aboard the boat. Take commemorative photos amidst the backdrop of the beautiful natural scenery and the Onaruto Bridge.			■ Cancellation Policy	A 100% cancellation fee will be charged for the boat charter fee with any cancellation after the reservation is made, excluding cases in which the boat cannot set out due to bad weather/strong winds. Key Point (3) Show with photo		III . Take your freshly caught fish to a local Japanese-style diner, where they will fillet and cook it for you to eat! Of the fish you catch, the skipper will select a few of the best to take to a local Japanese-style diner. Savor the fresh seafood dishes along with some warm miso soup!			■ Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Be sure to wear clothes that are easy to move around in, and that you wouldn't mind getting dirty. Keep your belongings to a bare minimum, as there is no baggage storage area on the boat. A 100% cancellation fee will be charged for the boat charter fee with any cancellation after the reservation is made, excluding cases in which the boat cannot set out due to bad weather/strong winds. (The tour can be held in rainy weather) For your safety, be sure to follow the skipper's instructions as to where to sit, where/how to move, etc., while on the boat. You will be provided with a life jacket. All other gear, including gloves, rubber boots, raincoats, and cold-weather apparel, are not available for rental. Be sure to bring your own if you think you will need it. Take care when handling the rental fishing rod/reel, etc., as you will be asked to pay a replacement fee (the asking price for the product) if you break it Depending on the currents on the day of the tour, you may not be able to catch any fish. If this happens, lunch will consist only of the regular menu at the diner in question. A few (2-3) of the fish caught by the group will be selected to be brought into the diner. Because the shop is very popular, there may be a wait before your lunch is served. The type of fish you can catch will differ based on factors such as the season and the time of day. The skipper will read the currents on the day of the tour and help you zero in on fish that you'd have a higher probability of being able to catch. There is no guarantee that you will be able to catch any fish. The tour also cannot take any requests regarding fish you would like to catch.
