[Outline of each spot] Nanmenzan Senko-in Yashimaji Temple: This temple is known as one of the 88 sacred places in Shikoku, and has a history spanning over 1000 years. The temple is also dedicated to the god of raccoon dogs, a rarity in Japan, and there are cute raccoon dog statues placed all over the temple grounds. Pass through the bright red Higashidaimon Gate and enter the spacious temple grounds, which exude an atmosphere of dignity. Nishione Observatory: This observatory is not on the tourist map of Yashima, making it the perfect off-the-beaten-path attraction. Historic Takamatsu Castle Ruins, Tamamo Park: The castle was built in 1588 by Chikamasa Ikoma, a vassal of Hideyoshi Toyotomi. The castle is famous for its location, facing the sea, a rare sight in Japan. Taking advantage of its location, the sea bream feeding experience is also popular.
