

## Context

To support National Federations and their Coaches the IBU offers the new IBU Academy Coach Education Programme consisting of 4 levels (basic, first, second, and third level). The pilot Second Level Course starts in September 2023.

## Participants

A maximum of 20 motivated candidates with advanced experience in coaching at the junior level or higher and coaches with a university education in sport science nominated by its National Federation.

## Lectures

Theoretical and practical lessons in the fields of skiing, shooting, applied training science, biathlon performance, exercise physiology, coaches' soft skills, nutrition, psychology, recovery & prevention, equipment, rules & competition, and integrity will be provided by well-known experts and coaches in the related fields.

Week 1: 23-27 September 2023 in Oberhof/GER

Week 2: 5 days, planned for 7-11 April 2024 in Norway

Week 3: 5 days, planned for 29 June - 3 July 2024 in Antholz/ITA

## Costs & Funding:

Costs & Funding: € 7 000 per person, excluding travel and accommodation costs. The NF can apply for financial support from the IBU development support 2023/2024 for a maximum of two candidates (1 man, and 1 woman) to cover the fee, accommodation, and travel costs.
