

WHAT IS EXPECTED FROM A CANDIDATE IF SHE IS ELECTED AS A MENTEE:

- 1. Participation in the kick-off meeting for the mentees.
- 2. Set (a) clear goal(s) and commit to doing your best to reach these goal(s).
- 3. Attend the sessions (60-90 Min) with your mentor from IBU and/or SheSkillz Global and work on the tasks the two of you agree on between the sessions.
- 4. 4 sessions with the mentor, from September 2023 and the next 6-8 months.
- 5. Participate in the webinars and meetings that will be offered specifically for the IBU group. Circa 1 meeting every second month. Topics in these webinars/meetings will help you to understand better leadership, management, organisation, and how to handle challenging situations. It will be a place to share experiences/meaningful topics when working in a biathlon organisation.
- 6. Attend group sessions with other participants, 4-6 participants in each group. One meeting each month from August/September. In these meetings, you will share experiences, support, and motivate each other. One of you will chair each meeting.
- 7. Attend IBU Gender Equality Forum that is planned for May 2024 (TBC).
- 8. Attend "Face to face" session(s) that will go over 3 days in 2024 (You'll be informed about the time/place).
- 9. Be prepared to share your experiences and challenges, goals, and where you are in the process.
