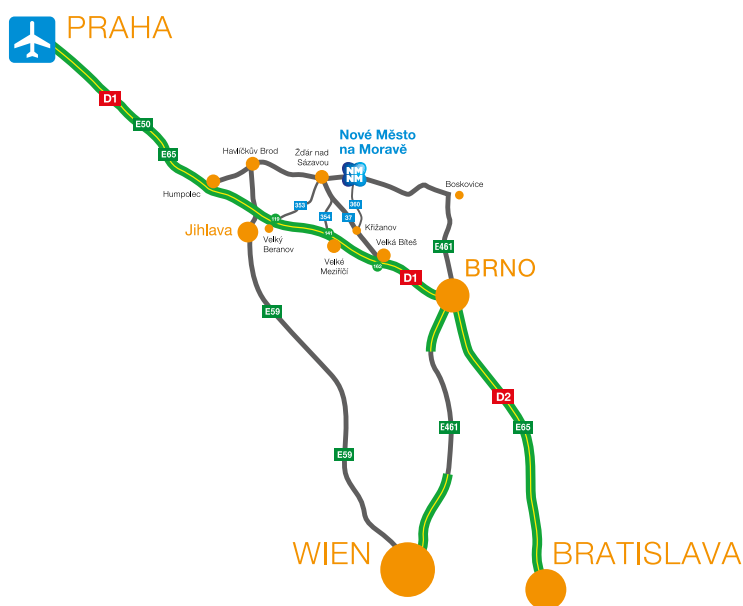

Registration

Each IBU NF can register up to four athletes of birth years 2007, 2008 (2 men and 2 women) and one coach. Registration is done through IBU Scope.

Deadline for registration is 31. 7. 2024

Accommodation

Participants of the camp will be accommodated in hotel SKI directly in Vysočna Arena NMNM.

Accommodation is usually in 2-bed rooms, sometimes 3-bed rooms are also possible.

Within the camp period and the national contingent, the organizer will cover the costs for accommodation and full board (1 non-alcoholic drink with meals included).

Check-in is scheduled on **Sunday by 17:00** at the latest, and departure on Saturday.

Different dates of arrival and departure must be agreed upon with the OC on time, and additional costs in the event of exceeding the planned time of the camp must be covered by the NFs (75 € per person per day).

Traveling

IBU supports NFs with travel contributions of 350 EUR per participating athlete if travelling by car and 500 EUR per participating athlete if flying.

Programme includes

- 6-night accommodation at hotel SKI NMNM in 2-3 bedrooms with full board
- one day trip to South Moravia - Lednice

Varied training sessions:

- on roller ski courses
- on the shooting range
- in the gym or on athletics stadium
- guidance by professional coaches
- seminars and lectures
- internship for top athletes
- supporting programme



- and International Youth Camp competition on Friday and Saturday

Necessary equipment

The following equipment is required for the varied training sessions:

- running shoes and sportswear
- roller skies and equipment (helmets are required)
- biathlon rifles and ammunition app. 500 per person
- gym sportswear and indoor shoes
- swimwear

VISA information

Citizens of the following IBU member countries need the entry visa when traveling to the Czech Republic / Schengen Zone: **ARM, CHN, KAZ, KGZ, MNG, TUR, UZB.**

All the above mentioned NFs must either have issued a VISA for Schengen Zone or submit a VISA Applications form to the Czech Biathlon Union for authorisation. This document will be subsequently sent back for Visa application.

Requests for authorisation must be submitted to the Czech Biathlon Union not later than **31. 8. 2024.**

Biathlon rifle and ammunition – import and export information

The import of rifles and ammunition to the Czech Republic is free of charge. Owners of the European rifle license (ERL). The Official invitation is needed when entering the Czech Rep.

Participants without the ERL entering and leaving the Czech Republic shall present the Official Invitation letter together with the **Waybill for transit of firearms and ammunition (WTFA) form**. Waybill will be issued by the Czech Police Authority based on the application submitted on a particular form (form is available in IBU Scope).

Form has to be sent to OC by email not later than 31. 8. 2024.

Together with the WTFA application form you are requested to send us:

- a copy of the passport of the person who is the application filled for (we recommend using person who will be traveling with the rifles)
- a copy of the document proving the relationship to the rifle (ownership or equipment loan agreement)

Once the WTFA is issued the Czech Biathlon Union will send it to the respective NF.

There are not any specific conditions for dry shooting in the Czech Republic. Rifles and ammunition must be handled safely and protected from hazardous use.



Other information

Weather

It can already be wintery at the end of October in Nové Město na Moravě, but there have also been unusually warm autumn days in recent years. So it's best to use weather apps to get up-to-date weather forecast in our location.

Insurance

According to the 1.6.2 ECR

All athletes and coaches participating in IBU events must possess both sufficient liability insurance, and sufficient accident insurance covering accident, recovery and transport costs - including competition - related risks - to an adequate extent. In addition, by the act of submitting their registration the NF confirms that its athletes are medically fit to participate at the time of submitting their registration.

National federations are responsible for ensuring that their athletes and coaches registered and deployed by them have the appropriate insurance coverage.

National federations and/or their athletes must be able to furnish proof of the respective insurance coverage at any time upon the request of the IBU, of the IBU's representatives and/or of the organizing committee concerned.

Language

The camp will be in English, and we hope for linguistic support from the present coaches.

Transport

The OC NMNM is able to transport of the teams from the Prague or Vienna Airports. Transport has to be payed according to the price list by NF.

Price list transport Prague or Vienna airport <=> NMNM/NMNM (and back):

- 4 persons 150 EUR (personal car - one way)
- 7 persons 200 EUR (minivan - one way)
- 20 persons 450 EUR (bus - one way)
