# This is what you need to do!

To be part of the international biathlon training group in Östersund:

- You are selected in a junior or senior national team or participate in the national development team
- You apply for studies and need to study at least 15 credits at Mid Sweden University during the academic year.
- You register your interest by email: idrott@miun.se

The number of athletes is limited, and selection is made by the involved parties. The fee will be determined later.

# This is what you get!

This is what you get when you join the international biathlon training group:

- Access to the gym and one VO<sub>2</sub>-test a year at NVC (National Winter Sports Centre on Campus Östersund) according to the regulations.
- Access to a training group (International RIU group) with a general training program provided by a part-time coach.
- A weekly joint group training session led by the coach, which may be held together with the Swedish RIU biathlon group.
- Access to the shooting range, paper targets, and ski tracks (including early snow) in Östersund.

- Fill out <u>this form</u> about elite level, get it signed by your National Biathlon Federation.

Are you from Norway, Finland, Denmark or Iceland (or have the requirements in Swedish language in other ways) you search education before April 15<sup>th</sup> at <a href="www.antagning.se">www.antagning.se</a> Then you only need to fill out <a href="mailto:this form">this form</a> about elite level, get it signed by your National Biathlon Federation and send it by mail to <a href="mailto:idrott@miun.se">idrott@miun.se</a> (if you apply for education at <a href="mailto:antagning.se">antagning.se</a> by yourself you don't need to fill out the form at the next page).

You need to study at least 15 credits at Mid Sweden University during the academic year to be a part of the training group. The group is limited in number of athletes, selection is made by involved actors. The training fee will be determined later.
