ABOUT THE CAMP and FESTIVAL

In collaboration with Liatoppen Biathlon Festival, the IBU and the Norwegian Biathlon Association are organising an international development camp for biathletes born in 2010 and 2011. The camp will take place in Geilo and at the Liatoppen venue Ål, from 15 April to 20 April 2026.

The Liatoppen Biathlon Festival is the world's largest biathlon competition for children in age groups up to 16 years old, with over 1000 participating biathletes. This will be an opportunity to participate in competitions and be a part of an international development camp to inspire and create learning for further development and dedication to biathlon. In addition, you will get to know athletes from around the world and create friendships inside the biathlon family. The participating coaches will also have a program focused on coach development and knowledge sharing.

This project is granted with the IBU Development support that contributes to event organisational costs, training and educational programme.

The participating NFs cover travel and accommodation costs.

Transportation during the event and full board per person in a single room: 1100 euros (Coaches) Transportation during the event and full board per person in a double room: 775 euros (Athletes) IBU supports NFs with travel contributions of 500 EUR per participant.

WHO CAN APPLY

The project is dedicated to the National Federations from B and C categories.

NFs apply via IBU Scope by 30th of November 2025. The applicant must provide sufficient information on the athletes' qualification process and motivation letter.

Only 8 NFs will be finally invited. Each Team should consist of a maximum of two female and two male athletes + one coach.

ANDRINE ØVERLAND HATLING is a former Norwegian biathlete who competed at the national senior level in Norway. She currently works as an activity consultant for the Norwegian Biathlon Association.



DAG BJØRNDALEN is a former Norwegian athlete with medals from the Olympics and the World Championships. Dag Bjørndalen currently works as a coach for biathletes at NTG Geilo, one of the most successful schools for the development of Norwegian biathletes. Few individuals have the experience and knowledge of biathlon as Dag Bjørndalen, from the club level to the elite level.

ATHLETE ROLE MODEL:



The Norwegian Biathlon Association and the OC of Liatoppen will provide an athlete representative from the Norwegian national team, who will offer valuable advice on further development as a biathlete to the participants at the camp.

EXPERTS:



VEGAR ROLFSRUD is the Head of Grassroot and Recruitment at the Norwegian Biathlon Association. His background is from working with venues and competitions, but also with the organisation in NF NOR, and he is a former Head Coach for Norway's para-team.



KNUT KUVÅS BREVIK is the Head of Coach Development and Education at the Norwegian Biathlon Association. He has extensive coaching experience across different age groups, including children, youths, and juniors, and has coached Norway's IBU Cup team. Additionally, he has served as the project leader for Norway's long-term athlete development model in biathlon and is a member of the IBU Academy's expert group.
