ABOUT THE CAMP

The IBU is hosting the **IBU Para Biathlon Development Camp** supported by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) to support developing Para Biathlon athletes and promote Para Biathlon in their countries. During the camp, participants will gain practical and theoretical knowledge about the sport and enjoy access to Para Biathlon theory and practical training sessions. The overall objective of the camp is help participating athletes and coaches improve their skills and competence for future participation in international level competitions. The target audience for the camp are developing athletes with limited or no high level Para Biathlon competition experience.

The IBU Para Biathlon Development Camp will take place in Hochfilzen, Austria from 16-21 September 2024, led by IBU Head Coach Rolf Nuber. Participation by nation is limited to 4 athletes/guides and 1 coach. Every country that sends athletes/guides must also send a coach. The camp will be conducted in English.

The camp will accommodate a maximum of 20 athletes. Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis, latest by 10 August 2024.

Accommodation is planned in double rooms for coaches and athletes. During the camp, the IBU will cover costs for accommodation and full board. Check-in is scheduled on Monday, 16 September by 17:00 CET at the latest, departure is on Saturday, 21 September after lunch. **Animals are not allowed**.

Different dates of arrival and departure must be agreed upon with IBU and additional costs in the case of exceeding the planned camp period must be covered by the federations.

If you cannot attend the camp and inform us later than 1st of September, the federation must cover the accommodation costs.

TRAVEL SUPPORT

The IBU supports NFs with travel contributions of 350 EUR per participating athlete/guide.

Local transportation from the hotel to the training location is the responsibility of the camp participants.

OTHER INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT

The following equipment is required for the varied training sessions:

- Roller ski training equipment
- Helmet
- Air rifle (VI rifles are provided by IBU)
- Swimwear
- Appropriate clothing for training
- Bad weather clothing (rain jackets etc.)
- Spotting scope with tripod (coaches)
- Clipboard for shooting (coaches)

VISA

The current <u>VISA regulations</u> for entry into Austria apply. Participating nations requiring an invitation must contact IBU.

INSURANCE

It is mandatory to possess both sufficient liability and accident insurance for covering accident, recovery and transport costs, including for Camp-related risks, to an adequate extent when participating in any camps, competitions or activities sanctioned or authorized by the IBU.
