What does the role involve?

As sustainability coordinator, you'll be part of defining future standards and creating awareness for sustainability and climate action in sport.

Your key responsibilities will be to support the implementation of measures to meet our climate neutral by 2030 and net zero by 2040 targets, work on awareness campaigns, and help organize virtual and in-person meetings for our stakeholders.

Tasks

The sustainability coordinator develops and supports sustainability programs, particularly the Erasmus+ funded projects in which the IBU participates. They also help implement the IBU's policies and regulations that aim to reduce the sport's environmental impact.

Moreover, they gather and analyze climate impact data to identify which areas need improvement, conduct research to determine the ideal practices to reduce this impact, produce progress reports, and implement solutions for problem areas when it comes to social or environmental sustainability in the IBU's event series.

Who should apply?

- Students or graduates with a degree in environmental sciences and/or sustainability.
