



GENERAL LIFE CYCLE OF AN APPLICATION FOR OS WORLD PROGRAMMES






1 - Standard options

The budget allocated to each project will depend on the results of the analysis of the budgetary proposal and will on average usually be between USD 25,000 and 30,000. The amount may be increased to USD 35,000 should this be both necessary and justified.



GENERAL LIFE CYCLE OF AN APPLICATION FOR OS WORLD PROGRAMMES

NOC submits application. OS analyses application (approval/advance payment). Activity takes place. NOC submits technical and financial reports. OS analyses reports (approval/balance payment). Reports and proof of expenses can be verified by the external auditor.

BUDGET

320 000 € - This budget includes 70 000 USD IOC findings

VISION

 Support of developing NFs with practical and theoretical knowledge about biathlon letting Athletes and Coaches improve their skills and competence for future participation in international competitions

OBJECTIVES

- Promotion of human resources in the host country
- Promotion of diversity and gender equality in sport
- Promotion of youth participation in biathlon
- Maintenance and improvement of the structure of the international training camps, taking into consideration the option of changing the hosting venue (mid-term planning) in some regions every other year to include more NFs in total
- Providing IBU-IOC assistance for national guidance and legacy in the respective hosting countries on the targeted continents
- Providing a combination of theory and practice in biathlon sport coaching as well as delivering organizational skills and guidance



GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- National Federations from C&D category are invited to participate with 1 Coach + 2 Athletes (Summer Camp) and 1 Coach + 4 Athletes (Winter Camp)
- We encourage to send young coaches (< 35 years) and preferably not the same coaches who participated in previous camps and coaches from IBU Academy</p>
- > Athletes (age 15-23) should know how to ski (rollerski) and shoot with a small-bore rifle
- > Registration for the Camps via IBU Scope (from 01 April 2023)
- > Accommodation and full board is paid by IBU as well as travel contributions for all participants
- Please note: NFs who registered to take part in the Camps and cancel their participation later than 1 week before Camp start will be excluded from the Camps for 1 year; NFs who arrive at the Camps with insufficient equipment will get a warning and will also be excluded for 1 year in case this happens twice

- In collaboration with IBU WCHs
 Organizing Committees
- With the Olympic Solidarity support
- Requires athlete's list approval from NOCs (invitation comes from NOC)
- Mainly for C&D category NFs but Bcategory NFs might also be considered
- Supported by IBU
- > Run by OCs



MATERIAL DISTRIBUTION 2023

Requirements:

- ✓ NEW: B, C, D and E Nations which have at least 4 athletes competing in minimum 2 IBU Competitions (incl. IBU Regional events)
- The value of the equipment package will be based on the number of athletes participating in IBU Events from previous season
- ✓ NEW: Wishlist will be collected this year already from April (Deadline: 31 May 2023)
