The FLS is a sports federation focused on developing, promoting and enhancing skiing. The federation wants to professionalize its sports activities and build a more structured technical approach. It provides you with the chance to participate actively and help build this professional structure.

#### **Mission**

Coordinate and develop competitive skiing in all age categories and disciplines of the FLS, ensuring athlete follow-up, sports organization, and relations with institutional partners.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- Define high-level sports policy and general guidelines for the training of athletes in collaboration with personal trainers and national institutions.
- Ensure the coordination and supervision of training and competition plans with federal and personal trainers, as well as any support structures.
- Participate in developing a strategy to detect and train young talent, tailored to the Luxembourgish school and sports system.
- Monitor medical, paramedical, safe-guarding, and anti-doping actions for athletes in cooperation with various national and international institutions
- Develop selection proposals for national and international competitions.
- Develop and promote activities to increase the visibility of ski racing in Luxembourg.

#### **Position and tasks in the structure**

- The Technical Director works under the authority of the FLS Board of Directors with operational autonomy in the field.
- Close collaboration with the various commissions and the FLS administrative manager.
- Participation in the organization of competitions, training camps, and training sessions.
- Development of the federal concept and strategy for the FLS Centre de Formation.
