Your Federation may send a maximum of **2** athletes (**1** female and **1** male athlete) and **1** Coach (in total **3** persons).

We welcome Coaches from our invited C & D level developing National Federations, but we recommend including young coaches under 30. If you have coaches who currently participate in the IBU Coach Education (Basic or First Level Course), please send these coaches - they can accomplish their requested practical hours at the Camp. Kindly note that the participating athletes should be within 15-23 years of age.

All costs for accommodation with all meals for the Camp days only (see "Date") and experts costs are paid by the IBU.

The IBU also supports you with the travel contribution in the amount of:

350 € per participant (Car reasonable)

500 € per participant (Flight required)

Please register your athletes and coaches by names in IBU SCOPE until 15 July 2022.

Good to Know

Camp procedure

1. Training equipment required from participants and ensured by the Federation

Athletes: roller skies, poles, rifle, rifle care materials

Coaches: coach's backpack, scope with tripod, clipboard

- 2. IBU will take care of the ammunition
- 3. The IBU Coaches will take care of the training plans. Before the Camp starts, IBU will organize an online meeting with the registered NF Coaches and IBU Coaches regarding the camp procedure and the training plans.
- 4. Side events and workshops focus on anti-doping, rules, training planning, a technique in shooting and skiing/roller skiing, etc.
- 5. The transport to/from the stadium should be organized by the participants (Carpools)

Insurance

1. It is mandatory to possess sufficient liability and accident insurance to cover accident, recovery and transport costs, including Camp-related risks, to an adequate extent when participating in any camps, competitions or activities sanctioned or authorized by the IBU.

COViD-19 regulation
