

- Betting-related issues
- Any kind of result manipulation

Status of Biathlon in International Sport

- Goal of the BIU to regain trust and confidence and establish the IBU as a role model for good governance in international sport
- Aligns with item 4.2 of Target 26: "Upgrading our governance, International involvement"

 - Council of Europe Anti-Doping Convention (evaluation of Russian Federation





WADA 2019 Testing Figures

- 5.5% increase in the overall number of samples analysed from previous year (2018)
- A slight decrease in the total percentage of Adverse Analytical Findings (AAFs): 1.05% in 2018 (2,774 AAFs from 263,519 samples) to 0.97% in 2019 (2,702 AAFs from 278,047 samples).





'The actual rate of doping has been approximated at 14–39 per cent of athletes, compared to the 0.5–2.0 per cent level of positive doping control tests. In surveys asking athletes and coaches to estimate doping, the numbers escalate further.'




