1. IBU Academy

a. JOURNAL OF BIATHLON COACHING

c. E-LEARNING PLATFORM: LEARNING SUITE

After the successful release of the public content section on the Learning Suite, we have now added around 1,600 athletes to the platform to share the knowledge of biathlon in terms of education and research. More than 2,600 users now have access to the Learning Suite. During the Q1 and Q2 of 2024, we will update the existing coach education courses on the platform and implement additional material for the IBU referee and the Para Biathlon referee education. For the First-level course, we will integrate a module for Para Biathlon.

d. RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAMME

For the cycle 2024/25, Universities and research groups can apply on IBU Scope until 31 March 2024. For the 6 selected Universities of the cycle 2023/24, we have received the interim reports, and we are expecting the interim financial reports by 15 February 2024 and the final reports by 30 June 2024. We have updated the athletes' email addresses in the last months and included about 1,600 athletes in our e-learning platform LearningSuite. This year, NFs can apply again for the Development Project "Athletes' Involvement after a sports career". The project supports athletes in their career transition, intending to keep more retired biathletes engaged within the biathlon family.

c. IBU Scope 2.1

From April 2024, we should move to the newly developed application tool IBU Scope 2.0. The system allows us to use the Microsoft environment better and is connected to the IBU CRM system and, in future, Power BI. We are in the testing phase, supported by some NFs and HQ Staff. The IBU Scope 2.0 shall be presented to NFs during the Development Info Day 2024.

e. Biathlon for All (B4A)- pilot project

The rifle sets are sent to 42 NFs. The first outcomes from the laser/optical rifle usage were collected via the survey by the end of December 2023. The second survey will be released at the end of March 2024. We collect the reports from National Project Coordinators with pictures and video.

We work on the logo and visual identity with support from the Communication Department.

We are finalising the concept of the **Kids and Youth Recruitment Forum in Östersund, Sweden**, which we are planning on **22-24 May 2024** as a part of the B4A project development. Forum Partner: Mid Sweden University.

The goal of the Forum is:

- to discuss the status of the 'Biathlon 4 All' project together with NFs and suppliers and the roadmap to its future
- share feedback about the laser/optical rifles from the National Federations, then the best practice examples



- discuss the laser/optical rifle specification for project needs (for kids U10, U12, U15)
- test various laser/optical rifles
- share communication ideas for promoting 'Biathlon 4 All' events and
- discuss designing the educational materials creation a toolkit for instructors, teachers, and coaches
