2	 Update Double Materiality Analysis Presentation of DMA results, identifying the top 10 sustainability issues based on stakeholder input, considering both financial and sustainability impact. Key priority issues include travel emissions, snow management, energy use, climate adaptation, waste, and social topics like access and inclusion. Feedback was provided on clarifying thematic areas such as biodiversity, entry-level access, and responsible marketing (each to be defined to clarify meant exactly under each of the top ten priorities) ACTION ITEM: IBU to further define each of the top 10 topics and develop operational implications for three levels: IBU HQ, IBU as an event owner, and IBU as a biathlon family leader. ACTION ITEM: Katrina offered to join the next DMA strategy call

4	Upcoming NF/OC Pre-Season Sustainability Webinar A pre-season sustainability webinar is planned for early to mid-November. Target groups: National Federations and Organizing Committees. Topics to include: - Learnings from Loop One Festival.

	 Updates on Decarbonisation Support Programme. Case studies from IBU Award applicants or Sustainable Development projects. Volunteers from the Commission are welcome to contribute as speakers. ACTION ITEM: IBU to set a date for the webinar (around 10th November) and prepare a first proposal of the agenda
5	 Update Milano Cortina 2026 & Future Games Current MoU with Milano Cortina 2026 and FIS focuses on temporary sustainable infrastructure. Webinar on 1 October. Limited sustainability momentum compared to Paris 2024. Challenges include venue distance, lack of central Olympic athlete village, and slower planning pace. For 2030 French Alps, more integrated and aligned planning is expected. IBU and EBU collaboration on sustainable broadcasting will continue this season, including future Albert or equivalent certification.
6	In-person meeting and upcoming Commission calls Discussions around next in-person meeting: Finals in Oslo, alternatively post season, combine meeting with other Commission (Development Commission) in May - ACTION ITEM: Decision regarding next in-person meeting to be taken in next Commission Call The group discussed whether monthly meetings are too frequent. - Consensus was to keep meetings every 4–6 weeks with flexibility during the competition season.
