We invite your National Federation to participate in the IBU-IOC Summer Training Camp 2021.

With the camps, the IBU aims to support the already existing biathlon structure in your Federation. Therefore, by providing expertise and guidance, we hope to help create a long-term legacy for our sport. Your Federation may send a maximum of 4 athletes (2 female and 2 male athletes) and 1 Coach (in total 5 persons).

Accommodation	Hotel Sport, Hotel Jelka, Hotel Center

We welcome Coaches from all our invited developing National Federations, but we recommend including young coaches under 30. Kindly note that the participating athletes should be within the range of 15-23 years of age.

All costs for accommodation with all meals for the Camp days (see "Date") and experts costs are paid by the IBU.

The IBU also supports you with the travel contribution in the amount of:

350 € per participant (Car reasonable)

500 € per participant (Flight required)

Good to Know

COVID-19 regulation

1. For the arrival, the Covid-19 PCR test not older than 48 is requested.

3. Regarding the final procedure, we will inform you before the camp starts

Insurance

1. It is mandatory to possess both sufficient liability and accident insurance for covering accident, recovery and transport costs, including for Camp-related risks to an adequate extent when participating in any camps, competitions or activities sanctioned or authorized by the IBU.

Camp procedure

1. Training equipment required from participants and ensured by the Federation
Athletes: roller skies, poles, rifle, rifle care materials
Coaches: coach's backpack, scope with tripod, clipboard
2. IBU will take care of the ammunition
3. The IBU Coaches will take care of the training plans. Before the camp starts, IBU will organize an online meeting with the registered NF Coaches and IBU Coaches regarding the camp procedure and the training plans.
4. Side events and workshops focus on anti-doping, rules, training planning, a technique in shooting and skiing/roller skiing, etc.
5. All registered Coaches will be required to attend the IBU Coach online seminar in September.
