FLORIDA MAN STEVE SCHALE SAYS

There has been a lot reported about the importance of voters in Florida who are not registered with either political party.

Right now, 22% of all who have voted do not have an affiliation with either major party (No Party Affiliation/NPA), and the share of these voters will only grow through Election Day. Let's explore for a second how they are different.

First: They are younger than the overall pool of voters so far. About 10% of all who have voted are under the age of 29, but over 13% of the NPA voters are under 29. They are more diverse than the electorate: 35% of all who have voted so far are non-white -- among NPA voters, it is 41%. And they are more likely to be new or "sporadic voters" - roughly 18% of

all who have voted so far are new registrants or those with sporadic voting histories, but among NPA, that share is 27%. Where these voters fall will likely determine who wins Florida.








