California residents have the right to designate an authorized person or corporate entity to exercise rights granted to them under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA). To make this designation, California residents may complete and submit this form. To the extent we are unable to verify the identity of the person submitting this form, we may request additional information from the person making the submission. Authorized agents that have been provided a valid power of attorney from a requestor may submit requests directly.
