HOW TO GET HERE...

BUS SERVICES

Shuttle Buses:

Southampton Football Club run a dedicated Shuttle Bus Service from two different locations for all home and away supporters – these are; Southampton Central Train Station and Town Quay. The service starts 2 hours before kick-off for all first team matches and run every 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic. Contactless payments are accepted.

Pick Up:

Southampton Central Train Station – Operates from the South side of the station (Platform 4).

Town Quay – Operates from Terminal 2 at Southampton's Town Quay. Services are timed to depart five minutes after the arrival of the Red Jet service from Cowes. Passengers can purchase bus tickets from Red Funnel with their ferry tickets. Supporters that use the Car Ferry and Hythe Ferry are also welcome on the buses.

Drop-Off:

Buses will drop off and pick-up supporters on Chapel Road. Return buses operate for 30 minutes after the final whistle.

TRAIN

Southampton is served by Southampton Central Railway Station, which is approximately a mile from the stadium - roughly a 20-minute walk.

Please see 'Train Station Shuttle' for details of the dedicated service to the station and back. The train station has staff available 24/7 and there are help points on every platform. There is a cash machine at the train station, as well as refreshment facilities, toilets, pay phones and shops. The station is fully accessible to wheelchair users 24 hours a day.

WALKING

As part of our HALO Effect, we encourage all supporters to walk or take public transport to and from St Mary's.

COACHES & MINIBUSES

There is free parking for visiting supporters who are travelling either by official supporter's coaches, private coaches or minibus on Britannia Road. Please note that although Britannia Road is restricted by a road closure 1 hour and 30 minutes before kick-off you can still gain access to this area.

MOTORCYCLES & CYCLING

Cycling is a quick and reliable way to get around

Southampton on matchdays. Most of the city is less than a


20-minute ride from St Mary's Stadium. For some, arriving
by motorcycle is also a good option. The football club has

FREE parking facilities at the stadium for those who cycle.

This can be found alongside the Kingsland Stand that is

situated at the rear of the stadium.

Please note that if you are traveling by motorcycle you should enter via the stadium's North Car Park and liaise with security on entry. If arriving by motorcycle, please do so no later than 1 hour prior to kick-off due to closures. These closures will remain in place until approximately 20-minutes after the final whistle.




VOI SCOOTERS

Before setting off please be aware that if you wish to bring a baby with you, they will still need a match ticket allocated to them.


UPON ARRIVAL

The away turnstiles and Ticket Office are located on the north side of the stadium. Visiting supporters can use turnstiles K, L, or M to access the away stand. The turnstiles will be opened 90 minutes prior to kick-off.

We have a process in place to make entry to St. Mary's for home and away fans as smooth and safe as possible.

When attending a match at St Mary's. we advise approaching the stadium via Britannia Road and entering through our entrance next to the North Car Park.

Please refer to the map on the right to see the area of the North Car Park that will be affected and the direction you should be following.





TICKETING

COLLECTIONS

Duplicate ticket requests will only be fulfilled if the information is sent to us, via email, from the visiting club's ticket office. If a supporter misplaces their ticket, they must contact their own club who will authorise and inform Southampton's Football Club's ticket office.

Duplicate tickets will not be issued without authorisation from a representative of the visiting club.

Duplicate tickets will be available to collect from Ticket
Office 3, the visiting supporters' Ticket Office up to 3 hours
before kick-off until 15 minutes into the match.

TOUTING INFORMATION

Match tickets obtained via unauthorised sources (other than via the club) are not valid. If you pay more than the face value of a match ticket or have bought a match ticket(s) from a tout or an online ticket agency such ticket will be invalid and you are likely to be refused entry or ejected from the stadium.

The unauthorised sale of football tickets is a criminal offence under UK law.


Southampton Football Club and/or any registered ticket agent will only sell match tickets for Southampton Football Club matches at face value plus any administration charge.

YOUR MATCHDAY

Southampton Football Club provides entertainment from the get-go on matchdays at St. Mary's Stadium. With a wide range of entertainment around the outside of the stadium, including the very popular Saints Brass.

Our Fan Zone is open to all supporters on a first come first serve basis and provides an outside area for supporters to soak up the matchday atmosphere prior to kick-off. For those who wish to watch the lunch time kick-off prior to the Saints on a Saturday, can do so. So why not soak up the early atmosphere within our Fan Zone!

CASHLESS STADIUM

St. Mary's Stadium is now completely cashless and therefore we do not take any cash payments. We accept all major debit and credit cards and mobile payments, such as Apple Pay and Google Pay.

GROUND REGULATIONS

SFC REPORT

At Southampton, we have a zero tolerance approach to any form of discrimination, bullying, victimisation or harassment.

It is vitally important to the Club that everyone feels welcome at St Mary's Stadium. This means that we will take the strongest possible steps to eliminate any form of discrimination from our stadium without exception.

If you are the victim or a witness to such behaviour we ask that you text 'SFCReport' to 60060 with a description and location of the incident, at the time of the incident. Please provide as much detail of any offence as possible.

This may include specific seat details if applicable, descriptions of persons involved, and exact words and phrases wherever possible. We recommend that you save the number to your phone and text discreetly to help us challenge bad behaviour at St Mary's. Supporters are also encouraged to report any behaviour that they are not comfortable with to any of our stewards or other staff. All reported concerns will be investigated appropriately and confidentially.

EVACUATION PROCESS

In the event of an emergency, please follow the instructions that are announced over the tannoy system and the directions of our stewarding team.

BANNERS/FLAGS

There is only a limited amount of space to display banners/ flags within the stadium. Banners/ flags above 1 metre square will not be accepted unless they have a fire certificate to say they are safe. Banners above 3 metres square have to be pre-arranged with the Safety Officer and may be refused. They must not obstruct view of others, cover advertising signs or cause a safety hazard. Banners/ flags must not display any abusive or threatening words, images or political statements.

BAG POLICY

All bags will be subject to a search prior to entry and must be small enough to fit under your seat, without causing any obstructions to the walkways.

THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES MUST NOT BE BROUGHT WITHIN THE GROUND; KNIVES, FIREWORKS, SMOKE CANISTERS, AIR HORNS, FLARES, WEAPONS, DANGEROUS OR HAZARDOUS ITEMS, LASER DEVICES, BOTTLES, GLASS VESSELS, CANS, POLES AND ANY ARTICLE THAT MIGHT BE USED AS A WEAPON AND/OR COMPROMISE PUBLIC SAFETY. ANY PERSONS IN POSSESSION OF SUCH ITEMS WILL BEREFUSED ENTRY INTO THE GROUND.
