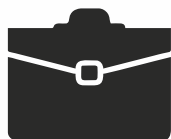

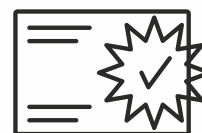

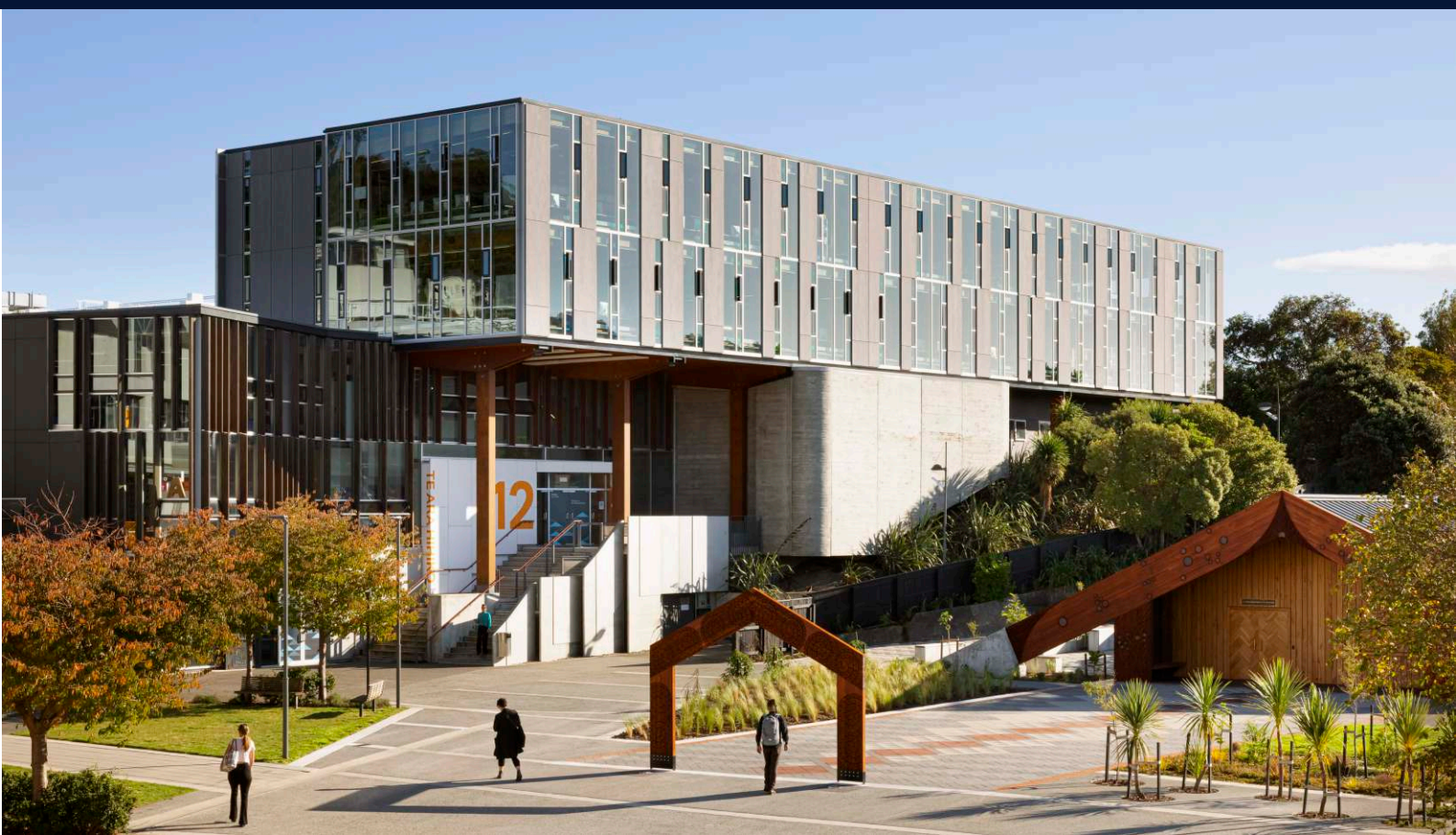

Your visa application fee
