

# Incidents in the Red Sea, Gulf of Aden, and Persian Gulf & its approaches

#### **Updated 3 June 2024**

Below is a list of incidents which have been recorded on the Risk Intelligence System during the past 30 days. Information includes date, time and a short description of the respective incident. Comprehensive descriptions for all incidents (as well as for older incidents) can be found on the Risk Intelligence System.

#### 29 April 2024, Bulk carrier Cyclades struck

The ship was reportedly targeted by up to three projectiles, with subsequent reports indicating that an explosion took place near the vessel and then that the vessel had sustained some damage, but that the crew were safe and proceeding.

#### 07 May 2024, Container vessel MSC Diego targeted

The ship reported two explosions in close proximity while transiting Northbound with the AIS off. Crew and vessel were safe, with the vessel then calling Djibouti.

#### 10 May 2024, Product tanker Chrystal Arctic reports failed boarding

One skiff reported a failed boarded by six armed men. A brief exchange of gunfire with embarked armed guards ended the attack. The incident has been classified as a pirate attack.

### 17 May 2024, Crude oil tanker Wind struck by missile

Panama-flagged tanker reported sustaining slight damage after being struck by one anti ship ballistic missile. Vessel lost and regained propulsion, and continued on voyage. All crew reported to be safe.

## 23 May 2024, Bulk carrier Yannis targeted by missiles

Malta-flagged bulk carrier reported suspected missile or drone impact in close proximity to ship's port side. Cew reported to be safe.

#### 28 May 2024, Bulk carrier Laax struck by missile

Marshall-flagged bulk carrier was repeatedly targeted by missiles and struck at least once. The crew are safe and is proceeding to their next port of call.
