





SUMMARY

- Age:** a decrease in the number of Non-Authorised roles within the 25-34 age band since 2013
- Gender:** females holding Non-Authorised roles still outnumber those within the other categories. There has also been a 75% raise in numbers since 2013 of females holding Authorised roles
- Disability:** 2 Authorised roles show data for disability, although not known which gender or whether relevant to age
- Ethnicity:** from all who answered 100% of staff class themselves as white
- Education:** as with the 2013 data collected. Most staff attended a UK state school with almost as many not attending universities within the Non-Authorised role
- Care:** there has been a 2% drop this year compared to the 60% of staff in 2013 holding Non-Authorised roles who were not primary carers of children under 18. Of those 12 Non-Authorised roles 92% do not have to care for others
