## BY BUS, ON FOOT OR BY BIKE, IT'S MORE ECO-FRIENDLY!

To reach your favorite artists, why not choose a more active and sustainable means of transport?



**Public transportation** : The Festival International de Jazz de Montréal is perfectly accessible by public transit, with three main metro stations - Berri-UQAM, Saint-Laurent and Place-des-Arts. And don't forget the ten bus routes that will take you there with ease!



**Bike**: Whether you're an avid cyclist or a weekend rider, the Quartier des Spectacles has everything you need: twenty [BIXI](#) stations, a well-designed network of bike paths, and even a secure on-site bike parking area so you can lock up your ride with peace of mind.



If you prefer driving, consider reducing your ecological footprint by combining different modes of transportation: why not drive to the nearest metro station, for example?



**Carpooling** : with friends ([Amigo Express](#)), car-sharing services ([Communauto](#)), and eco-friendly taxis ([Téo Taxi](#) and [Véco](#)) are also great alternatives to explore for greener travel!

Throughout the site, clearly marked bins make it easy to sort between composting, recycling, returnable containers, Écocups and garbage.



Special mention for reusable cups ! Écocups are collected, washed right on the festival site, and redistributed in concessions — just make sure to place them in the correct bin before leaving.
