

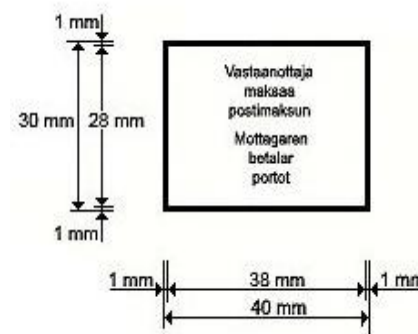
Markings for domestic and international reply mail items



Domestic reply mail items

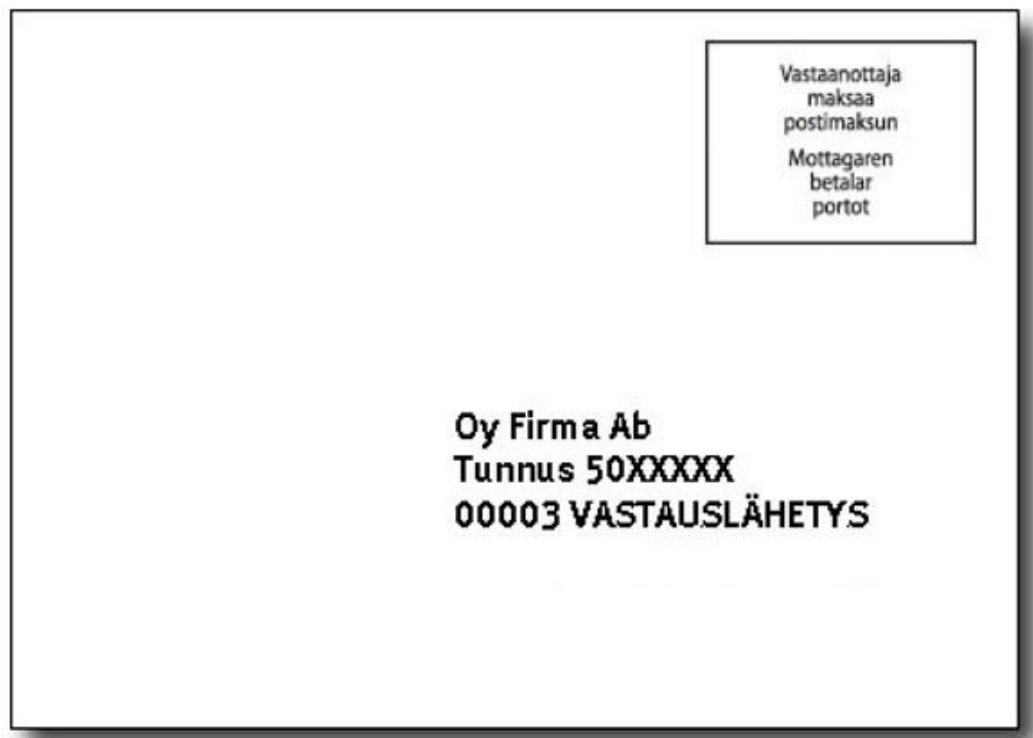
- The payment indication of both Economy and Standard Reply mail items is a black rectangle with a recommended size of 30 x 40 mm.
- **The postal code of reply mail items is always 00003 REPLY MAIL ITEM** (00003 VASTAUSLÄHETYS, 00003 SVARSFÖRSÄNDELSE)
- See the placement of address markings on the following pages.
- Please note that the address markings must not contain blank lines.
- Info code is not mandatory, but we recommend using it.

Payment indication: Reply Mail Item 00003

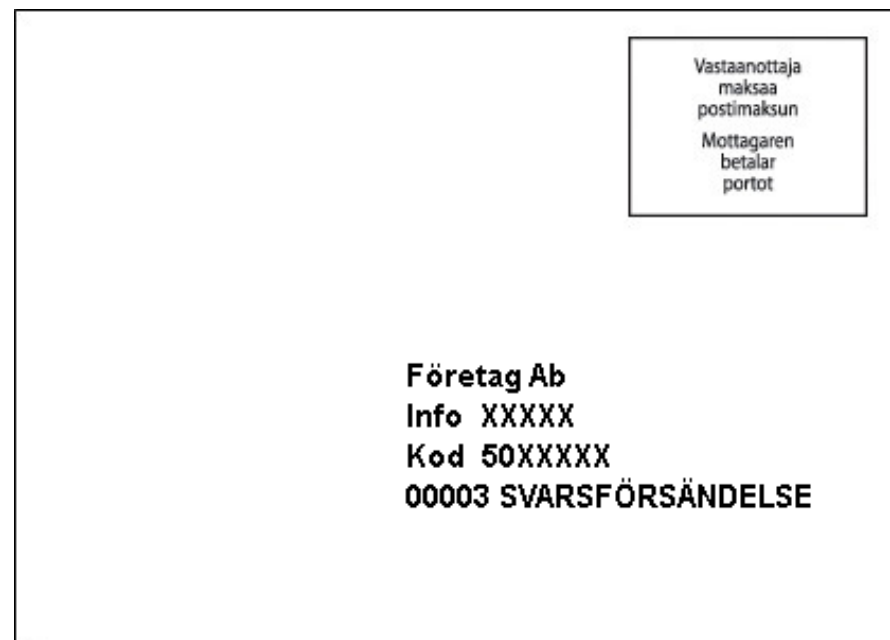
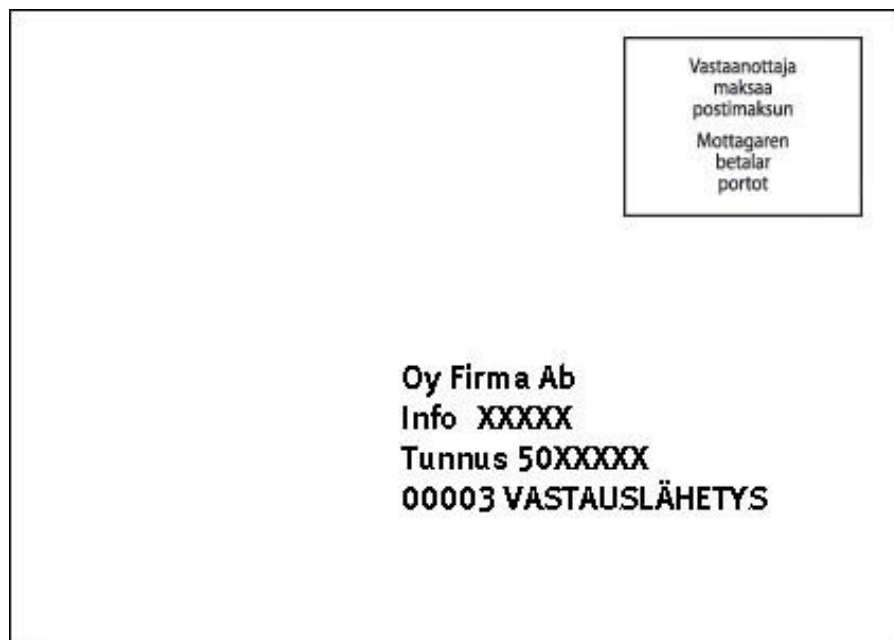


- Free text, but it should fit inside the rectangle (no logos, etc.)
- Rectangle (h x w) 30 mm x 40 mm (+/- 1 mm)
- Rectangle line thickness 1 mm (no less than 1 mm, max. 2 mm)
- Payment indication color: black

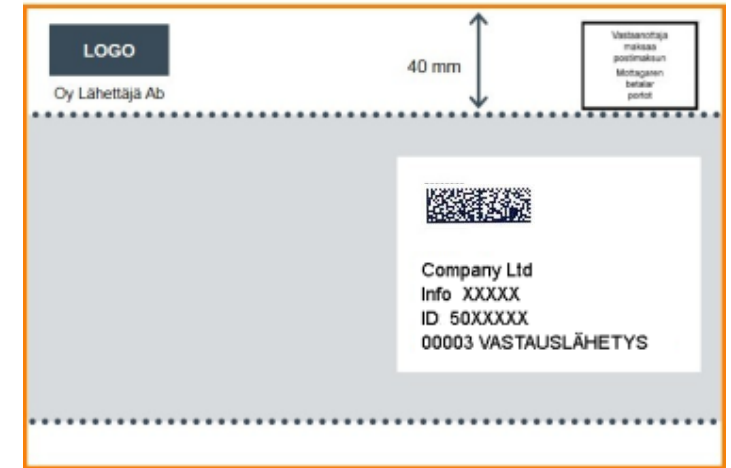
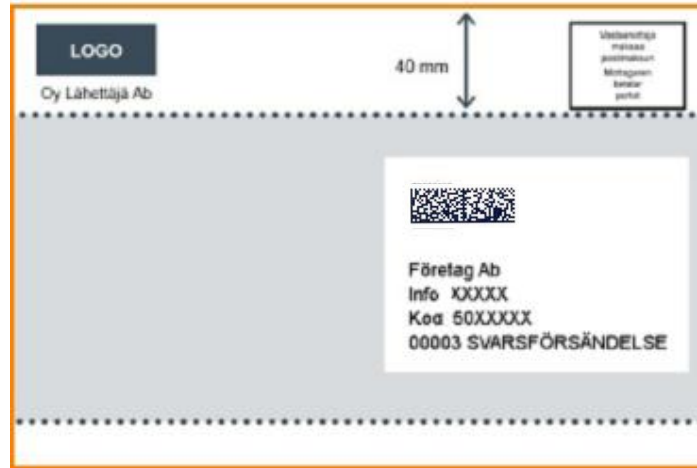
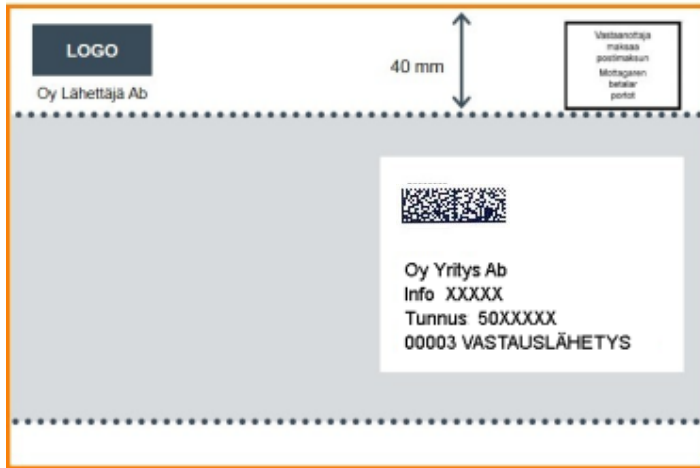
Reply mail without info code



Reply mail with info code

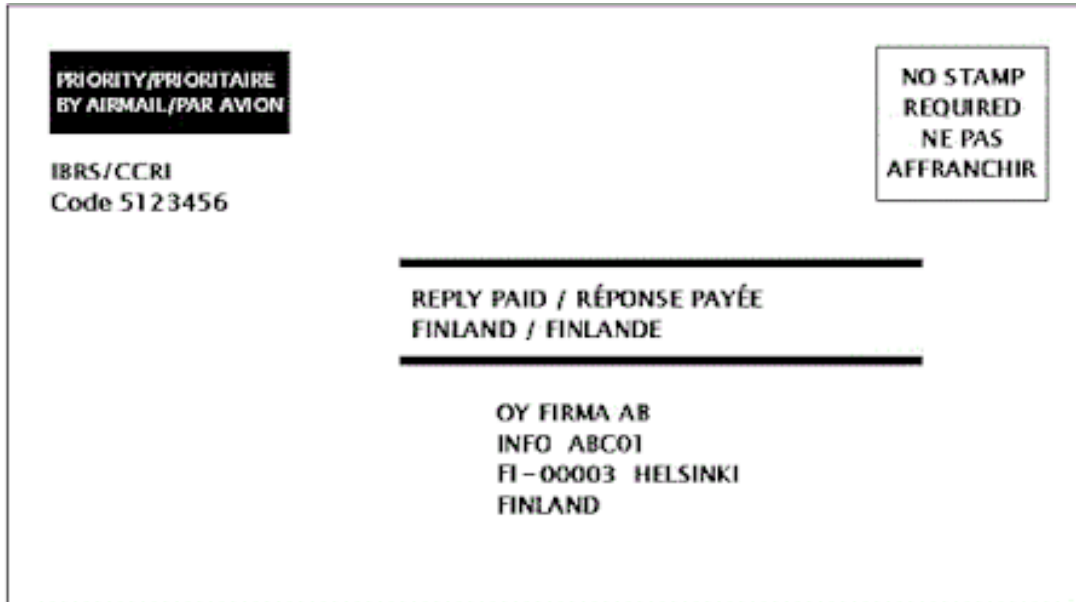


Standard Reply



- Except for the address field, the other texts and pictures on the envelope can be colored as long as the color restrictions of the border areas are followed.
- The 2 D code can be placed above to the address marking or next to it on its right-hand side.
- The address marking should not contain empty line spaces or handwritten information.
- The order of the lines in the address marking should follow the pictured model.

International reply mail item



- The reply mail item can be a preprinted coupon, envelope, card or, in certain countries, a box that is the same size as a standard letter.
- Its indication includes two thick horizontal lines.
- The horizontal lines must be 3 mm thick and placed 14 mm apart.
- All indications should be printed in a dark color, preferably black or dark blue, so that they stand out well from a light-colored background. They can be printed on an adhesive label. Handwritten indications are not accepted.
- The indications should be printed in French or English, and the postal code is FI-00003 HELSINKI, FINLAND.
