

Products: Sierra Wireless intelligent gateways, programmable modems, network appliances and cloud services

This bulletin provides information about the impact of CVE-2014-6271, known as “Shellshock”, on Sierra Wireless products.

Issue Description

CVE-2014-6271 describes a vulnerability that may allow an attacker to execute unauthorized operations on devices running an affected version of GNU Bash. The following sections detail which Sierra Wireless products are affected by this issue and recommended actions for the affected products.
