

Products: Sierra Wireless intelligent gateways

This bulletin provides information about the impact of CVE-2015-0325, known as “Ghost”, on Sierra Wireless products.

Issue Description

CVE-2015-0235 describes a vulnerability that may allow an attacker to execute unauthorized operations on devices running with an affected version of the GNU C library (glibc). The following sections detail which Sierra Wireless products are affected by this issue and recommended actions for the affected products.

Products Affected

Product	Affected by CVE-2015-0235
Raven, PinPoint and MP	No
GX400, GX440, ES440 and LS300	Contains the vulnerable code referred to by CVE-2015-0235 but unlikely to be exploitable by an attacker. As a precaution, Sierra Wireless is releasing updated versions of ALEOS 4.4.0 and 4.4.0b that eliminate the vulnerable code.



Recommended Actions for Affected Products

Product	Software version	Recommended Action	Availability
Verizon GX440 and GX450	4.4.0b build 4 and earlier	Upgrade to ALEOS 4.4.0b build 5	February 20, 2015
GX400, LS300 and non-Verizon GX440 SKUs	4.4.0 build 11 and earlier	Upgrade to ALEOS 4.4.0 build 12	February 20, 2015
