- ✓ Only one letter may be from a teacher.
- ✓ A short essay (typed, 300 words maximum) that explains why you consider yourself to be deserving of the award. Closely relate your own experiences and accomplishments to the principles and values that James Miller held in high regard.
- ✓ A short essay (typed, 300 words maximum) describing the importance of forests to communities in Northern Ontario.
