Tino rangatiratanga, Self-determination – Māori autonomy, authority, partnerships.

Taonga, Active protection – Māori treasures including knowledges, values, processes.

Ngā tikanga katoa rite tahi, All the rights and customs

- access, participation, equity, equal outcomes.

Ngā ritenga Māori, Māori (spiritual) customs

- respect for tapu, mana, integrity, health and wellbeing.
