Legislative Alert

Points of interest:

- 1. Open procurement legislation has been introduced in several states.
 - a. Would force utilities to seek bids for all pipe materials and accept the lowest.
- 2. The legislation forces the selection of pipe materials based solely on price.
- 3. Project managers and design engineers would no longer have the ability to decide on the pipe material for their projects.
- 4. AWWA believes that not all pipe materials are equally suitable for all applications.
- 5. The legislation would have a negative effect on the ability of utilities and design professionals to best serve their communities.
- 6. Recommendations:
 - a. Inform AWWA Government Affairs office of any activities associated with this effort in your community.
 - b. Educate other water works professionals and elected officials about this effort to help prevent the legislation.

- 1. Good response from AWWA about the dangers of the open procurement legislation.
- 2. Utilities can currently choose to use any pipe material they want and many have decided that materials that the legislation would force them to use aren't acceptable.
