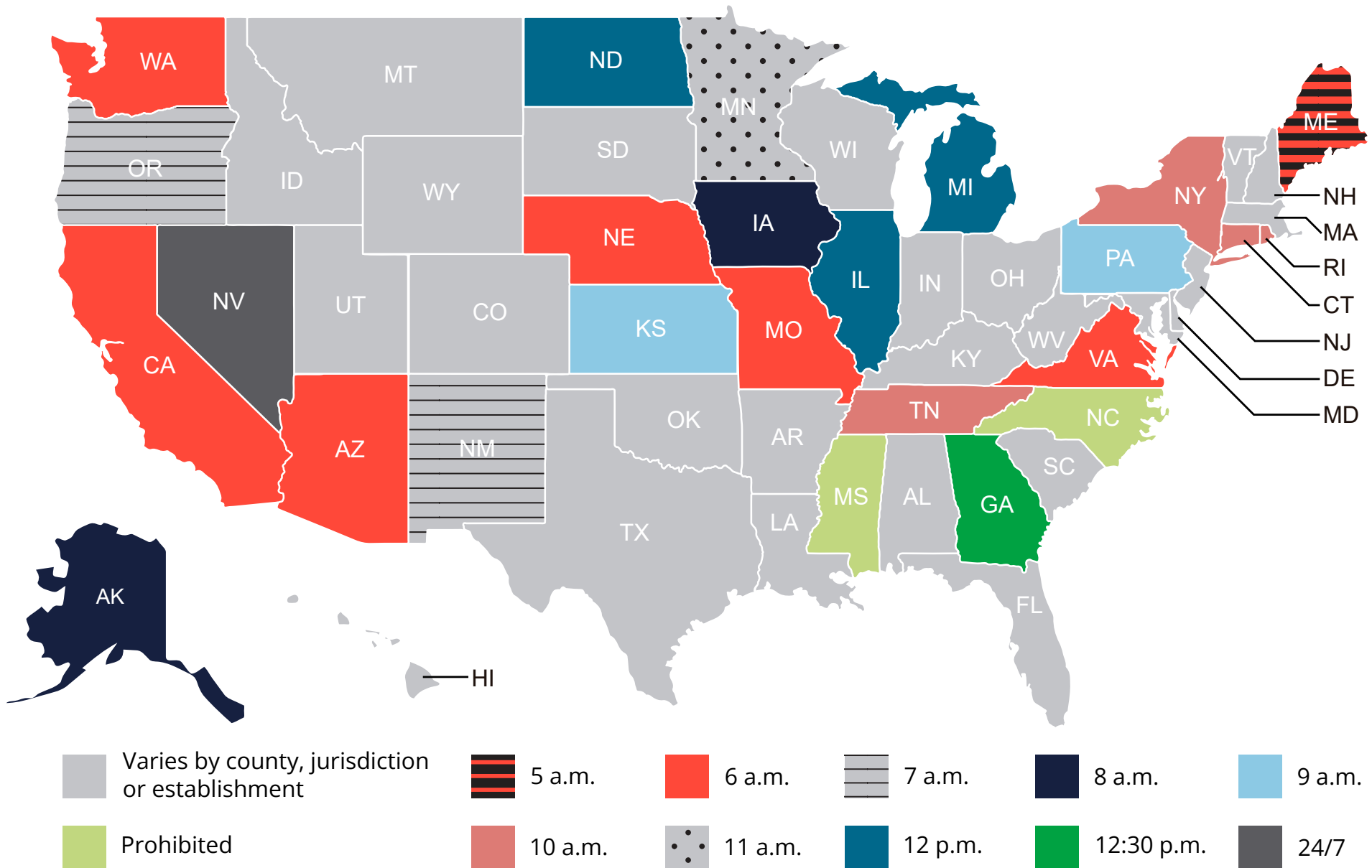


When Sunday Alcohol Sales Start by State



The start time for alcohol sales on Sunday varies by state and type of beverage being sold.



To get the most accurate information for your location, check with local retailers or look up regulations for your specific area.

Table of Sunday Alcohol Sales Times



State	Sunday Alcohol Sales Hours	Overview
Alabama	Varies	Alcohol sales on Sundays are generally allowed after 12:30 p.m., though local jurisdictions may impose their own restrictions.
Alaska	8 a.m. to 5 p.m.	Licensed businesses may sell alcohol from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., but local jurisdictions may place their own restrictions.
Arizona	6 a.m. to 2 a.m.	Alcoholic beverages may be sold daily from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. for both on- and off-premises consumption.
Arkansas	Varies	There are 29 dry counties in Arkansas. Where permitted, establishments may sell alcohol for on-premises consumption from 10 a.m. to midnight on Sundays.
California	6 a.m. to 2 a.m.	Alcohol may be purchased for on- and off-premises consumption from 6 a.m. until 2 a.m. every day. Some counties may extend these hours for beer sales. However, selling alcohol outside regular hours is considered a misdemeanor.
Colorado	Varies	Alcohol can be sold from 8 a.m. to midnight for off-site consumption. Licensed establishments can sell liquor from 7 a.m. to 2 a.m. daily. Colorado had a Sunday liquor sales ban in place since Prohibition, but it was lifted in 2008 when Senate Bill 82 was passed.
Connecticut	10 a.m. to 6 p.m.	Connecticut allows alcohol sales from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. for on- or off-site consumption, though local ordinances may vary.
Delaware	Varies	Off-premises alcohol sales are allowed on Sundays from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., and on-premises sales are permitted from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m.

State	General Sunday Alcohol Sales Hours	Details
Georgia	12:30 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.	Some on-premises establishments may sell alcohol as early as 11 a.m. on Sundays, but the state has a hard last call mandate set at 11:30 p.m.
Florida	Varies	Sunday alcohol sales laws in Florida vary by county. Some areas allow liquor purchases from 7 a.m. to 2 a.m., while others permit sales 24/7.
Hawaii	Varies	Liquor retailers may sell alcohol on Sundays from 6 a.m. until 11 p.m. Restaurants and bars may sell liquor from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m. or until 4 a.m. if they have a “cabaret license.”
Idaho	Varies	Liquor cannot be sold on Sundays in Idaho, but some counties have exceptions to this rule. Depending on the county, beer and wine sales are typically allowed on Sundays from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.
Illinois	Noon to midnight	Alcohol sales are permitted from 12 p.m. to 12 a.m. daily for on- or off-premises consumption, though some areas may impose their own restrictions.
Indiana	Varies	On-premises sales are permitted from 7 a.m. to 3 a.m. and off-premises sales are allowed from noon to 8 a.m.
Iowa	8 a.m. to 2 a.m.	Iowa permits alcohol to be sold from 8 a.m. to 2 a.m. on Sundays. Sales may begin at 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday.
Kansas	9 a.m. to 8 p.m.	Most areas allow Sunday alcohol sales from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., though some counties ban sales altogether.
Kentucky	Varies	Some counties permit alcohol sales on Sundays (usually after noon) while others prohibit liquor purchases.
Louisiana	Varies	Liquor purchase times vary by parish and the beverage’s alcohol content.
Maine	5 a.m. to 1 a.m.	Alcohol may be sold from 5 a.m. to 1 a.m. daily.

State	General Sunday Alcohol Sales Hours	Details
Maryland	Varies	Most counties in Maryland prohibit alcohol sales on Sundays, but those that don't usually allow purchases between 8 a.m. and 11 p.m.
Massachusetts	Varies	Alcohol can be sold on Sundays for off-premises consumption from 10 a.m. to 11 p.m. and from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m. for on-premises consumption.
Michigan	Noon to 2 a.m.	Some retailers may obtain a special license to sell alcohol on Sundays starting at 7 a.m.
Minnesota	11 a.m. to 6 p.m.	Local municipalities may impose their own restrictions.
Mississippi	Prohibited	Currently, alcohol sales are banned on Sundays. Mississippi's House Bill 329 passed in March 2024 but failed in the Senate. It would have allowed package stores to sell alcohol from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Sunday.
Missouri	6 a.m. to 1:30 a.m.	Missouri passed a law in August 2021 that changed Sunday alcohol sales times to coincide with other days. Before the law was enacted, liquor could only be sold from 9 a.m. to midnight on Sundays.
Montana	Varies	Sunday alcohol sales laws vary but are more lax for beer and wine purchases, state-run liquor stores, bars and restaurants.
Nebraska	6 a.m. to 1 a.m.	Some exceptions may apply.
Nevada	24/7	Nevada does not have any alcohol sales limitations in place.
New Hampshire	Varies	Alcohol can be sold from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m. for on-premises consumption and from 6 a.m. to 11:45 p.m. for off-premises consumption.
New Jersey	Varies	Many counties prohibit alcohol sales from 3 a.m. to noon, but some allow sales starting at 9 a.m.
New Mexico	7 a.m. to midnight	Hours can vary by establishment license and local jurisdictions may impose different regulations.

State	General Sunday Alcohol Sales Hours	Details
New York	10 a.m. to 10 p.m.	On-premises sales are allowed until 4 a.m. on Sundays.
North Carolina	Prohibited for hard liquor	Hard liquor sales are currently prohibited. However, SB 527, if passed, will allow ABC stores to sell alcohol on Sundays from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.
North Dakota	Noon to 1 a.m.	Establishments may serve alcohol until 2 a.m. on Sundays for on-site consumption.
Ohio	Varies	Local jurisdictions may set their own rules for Sunday alcohol sales. Many sell liquor from 10 a.m. through midnight.
Oklahoma	Varies	Some counties permit alcohol sales on Sundays from noon to midnight, but most ban liquor sales entirely.
Oregon	7 a.m. to 10 p.m.	Retail stores may choose different hours for sales.
Pennsylvania	9 a.m. to 2 a.m	Businesses must obtain a Sunday Sales Permit to sell alcohol within this timeframe.
Rhode Island	10 a.m. to 6 p.m.	Bars may stay open until 1 a.m. on Sundays.
South Carolina	Varies	Alcohol can only be sold at restaurants and bars on Sundays, but retailers may obtain a permit to sell between 1 p.m. and 5 p.m.
South Dakota	Varies	Alcohol sales hours on Sundays vary by county and the type of establishment.
Tennessee	10 a.m. to 11 p.m.	Restaurants and bars may sell alcohol until 3 a.m.
Texas	Varies	Liquor stores are closed on Sundays in Texas. Beer and wine may be sold at convenience stores with varied hours. Restaurants with food service may start selling alcohol at 10 a.m.
Utah	Varies	Laws vary based on the type of establishment and alcohol served.

State	General Sunday Alcohol Sales Hours	Details
Vermont	Varies	Different types of licenses will determine an establishment's alcohol sales times on Sundays.
Virginia	6 a.m. to midnight	Some establishments may sell alcohol for on-premises consumption until 2 a.m. Some liquor stores are only open from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Sundays.
Washington	6 a.m. to 2 a.m.	State liquor stores have varying hours, with some choosing not to open on Sundays.
West Virginia	Varies	Sunday alcohol sales times vary depending on the type of establishment and beverage.
Wisconsin	Varies	On-premises establishments may sell alcohol on Sundays from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. Off-premises establishments may sell wine and liquor from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. and beer until midnight.
Wyoming	Varies	Although state law allows alcohol to be sold 24/7, local governments may impose their own regulations.
