

6.1 Operator shall inform each of its TNC Authorized Drivers of the Authority's requirements to observe and comply with the following standards and criteria while at the Airport:

- A. The TNC Authorized Driver shall display the Operator decal as required by state law while operating at the Airport.
- B. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not enter the Geofence unless the driver's Mobile App is engaged.
- C. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not solicit, entice, or otherwise influence any person to occupy or engage a TNC Vehicle for transportation from the Airport.
- D. The TNC Authorized Driver shall remain with the TNC Vehicle at all times when at the Airport, except when required by the Authority to do otherwise.
- E. Without exception, the TNC Authorized Driver shall not permit any passenger, visitor guest or any other persons, other than a bona fide owner/operator not then under suspension or trainee, to be in, occupy or use his/her TNC Vehicle, while in the Holding Area of the Airport. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not permit any other person to occupy or ride in the TNC Vehicle unless the fare paying person(s) consents to the acceptance of additional passenger(s). Additionally, the TNC Authorized Driver shall not transport any animal unless such animal belongs to a farepaying passenger(s) occupying or otherwise hiring the TNC Authorized Driver's vehicle.
- F. The TNC Authorized Driver shall park only in areas designated by the Authority while waiting for passengers who have pre-arranged pick up from the Airport and shall not unduly block or delay or otherwise interfere with the normal progress of other ground transportation vehicles. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not sleep, nap or "doze off" while in the TNC Vehicle on the Airport.
- G. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not travel to or wait in any other parking structures or parking lots other than the designated areas and shall not pick up or drop off passengers in any unauthorized area.
- H. The TNC Authorized Driver shall conform to Airport speed limits and other traffic and parking regulations, and shall operate the TNC Vehicle in a safe manner at all times.
- I. The TNC Authorized Driver shall maintain personal appearance and grooming so as to present a favorable image at all times while the TNC Driver is in service at the Airport. The TNC Authorized Driver shall be hygienically clean and suitably dressed.

- J. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not engage in loud, profane, threatening or abusive language; disruptive conduct; or fighting and shall not engage in any form of card playing or in any gambling or other games of chance on the Airport. If the TNC Authorized Driver is observed by Authority personnel to be engaged in any such activity, or the TNC Driver is specifically identified in a written Authority mIncident Report or Police Report as having been engaged in such activities, the TNC Authorized Driver shall be prohibited from operating at the Airport until the TNC Authorized Driver presents verifiable evidence, satisfactory to the Authority, justifying or mitigating such activity. Reinstatement shall be at the sole discretion of the Authority.
- K. The TNC Authorized Driver shall be courteous at all times. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not be required or permitted to perform any service normally, or traditionally, performed by “Sky Caps” when a Sky Cap is on duty.
- L. Littering the Airport is prohibited. Cleaning interior and exterior of TNC Vehicles while waiting in the TNC Loading Area or Holding Area is not permitted. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not perform preventive maintenance on the TNC Vehicle on Airport property (e.g. tire rotation, oil change, tune-up, etc.), or any other repairs, major or minor. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not deposit household trash in Authority receptacles.
- M. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not be under the influence of, bring or consume alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs, nor bring any deadly or dangerous weapon, on the Airport unless the TNC Authorized Driver has been granted the right to carry such weapon from the appropriate governmental authority and in no event shall any deadly or dangerous weapon be displayed or used on the Airport.
- N. All trips to or from the Airport by an TNC Authorized Driver shall be made with the TNC Operator’s Mobile App on and engaged so that the Operator’s software can track the TNC Driver’s activity while in the Geofence. The fare for such trip(s) shall be at the rate(s) prescribed by the Operator in the manner required by law, except to the extent that “flat rate” trips are permitted or required by law. The TNC Authorized Driver shall not charge a fare that is greater than the Mobile App rate plus the TNC Trip Fee.

6.2. Operator agrees that its TNC Authorized Drivers are subject to random inspection by the Authority at any time and without advance notice to determine compliance with the standards set forth herein. Such inspections shall be in compliance with the nondiscrimination standards as outlined in the accompanying Operating Agreement. Inspections shall be made at the time and in the place designated by the Authority and shall be conducted so that the TNC Authorized Driver failing to pass the inspection shall

be able to depart the Airport immediately and shall not be permitted to load passengers at the Airport until all specified unsatisfactory condition(s) are corrected.
