Lionheart Acquisition Corp. II (NASDAQ: LCAP) Merges with MSP Recovery at a Pro Forma Enterprise Value of \$32.6 billion





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Transaction Overview

Transaction Summary

- On July 12, 2021, MSP Recovery, a healthcare claims reimbursement and recovery firm, announced that it will become a publicly traded company through a merger with Lionheart Acquisition Corp. II (NASDAQ: LCAP), a special purpose acquisition company (SPAC)
 - The combined company is expected to trade on Nasdaq under the symbol "MSPR" once the transaction is finalized in the fourth quarter of 2021
- The transaction values MSP Recovery at a pro forma enterprise value of \$32.6 billion
 - According to the companies, this merger represents one of the top three largest SPAC transactions ever announced to date
- MSP Recovery specializes in Medicare Secondary Payer recovery rights and the recovery of improperly paid Medicaid, and commercial payments
 - MSP is an industry veteran in gathering reimbursements for Medicare, Medicaid, commercial insurance, and other healthcare entities
- The Company has received historical financial backing from investment partners, including Virage Capital Management LP and its managed private investment vehicle, Virage Recovery Master LP ("VRM")
- The merger is expected to accelerate MSP's acquisitions of claims portfolios while further scaling and enhancing its dataanalytics capabilities within its existing infrastructure
- MSP will continue to be managed by its existing senior executive team, led by Chief Executive Officer, John H. Ruiz

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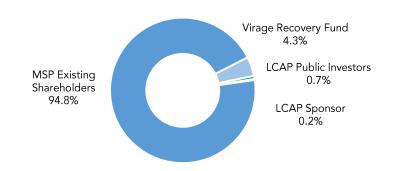

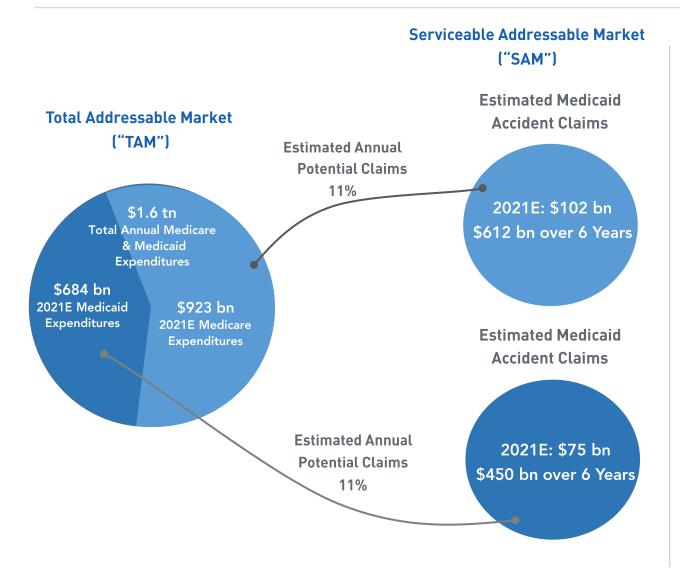

 - Transaction includes commitments for \$300 million PIPE from investor group including existing investor Wellington Management, as well as funds and accounts managed by BlackRock, Dragoneer Investment Group, Fidelity Management & Research Company LLC, Franklin Templeton, certain funds managed by Millennium Management, funds and accounts advised by T. Rowe Price Associates, Inc., and Winslow Capital Management, LLC
- Payoneer is a global payment and commerce-enabling platform which powers growth for millions of digital businesses worldwide – Payoneer's mission is to democratize access to financial services and drive growth for digital businesses of all sizes from around the world

Significance of Transaction

- While creating significant liquidity for existing shareholders, Payoneer's Management team will continue to lead the merged Company as over 68% of existing Payoneer equity is expected to be rolled as part of the transaction
