Transaction Summary

- On October 4, 2017, Navient (NasdaqGS:NAVI) announced it has entered into an agreement to acquire Earnest for \$155 million in cash
 - The transaction is expected to be dilutive to Navient's GAAP 2018 EPS by \$0.08 - \$0.10 and accretive to GAAP EPS in the second half of 2019
 - In order to allocate more capital towards the education lending business, Navient will suspend its remaining share repurchase program through the end of 2018
 - Navient's annual dividend of \$0.64 per share will not change
 - The acquisition is expected to close in the fourth quarter of 2017 and is subject to customary closing conditions
- Following the transaction, Earnest will continue to operate as a distinct brand
 - Earnest's current management team, including the founders Louis Beryl and Ben Hutchinson, will continue to lead the Company
 - Earnest's leading technology platform will be combined with Navient's industry and capital markets expertise to deliver more value to consumers and investors
 - As part of Navient, Earnest will be able to reach more borrowers and possibly offer lower interest rates





Overview of Transaction

- On November 17, 2015, Earnest announced a minority \$75mm Series B equity financing round
- The round was led by Battery Ventures with participation from Adams Street Partners and existing investors, including Maveron
- Earnest plans on using the equity financing to continue building out current technology, data and engineering teams
- In conjunction with the equity raise, Earnest also announced an additional \$200mm of institutional lending capital from New York Life and others
- Additional lending capital will enable Earnest to introduce new products, tools and resources in the near-term as the Company is planning expansion into additional consumer finance verticals
- Earnest is a leading technology-enabled alternative lending company that is intent on disrupting consumer lending; the Company utilizes superior technology to provide lending and refinancing solutions to consumers at better rates than traditional lenders
